**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Allows county approval of firearms training facility on lot or parcel that is exclusive farm zone, forest zone or mixed zone if lot or parcel not within city or urban growth boundary.

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** "Firearms training facility" is defined as an indoor or outdoor facility that provides training courses and issues certifications that are required: 1) for law enforcement personnel; 2) by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife; and 3) by nationally recognized programs that promote shooting matches, target shooting and gun safety.

Senate Bill 86 clarifies what lots or parcels may be approved by a county for the placement of such a facility.
