HB 2745 and HB 2941 is an opportunity for Oregon to make local clean solar energy accessible to all Oregonians. We thank you for your consideration of the legislation and encourage passage of these bills.

HB 2745 - Solar Feed-In-Tariff - is uniquely Oregon and allows independent minded Oregonians the ability to control their utility bills. Feed-In-Tariff subscribers are:
