How Does HCD Grant Work?

- The current law on the High Cost Disabilities (HCD) Grant states that for a student with approved disabilities costs above \$30,000, the grant is the total cost minus \$30,000.
- The district grant is the sum of the grants for each student with disabilities costs above \$30,000.
- The total grants of the HCD Grant cannot exceed \$18 million per year. If the grand total of the grants initially exceeds this amount, the grants to all school districts are reduced proportionally.
