## SB 5543 2013-15 Budget Rebalance

Senate Bill 5543 is a budget reconciliation bill that implements the rebalanced state budget for the 2013-15 biennium. It should be noted that the rebalance actions needed for the Department of Human Services and the Oregon Health Authority will be considered at a later time. As amended, the bill makes various technical adjustments to agency budgets previously passed by the Legislature and finalizes some General Fund components of the statewide budget.

## Actions include, but are not limited to:

- Reduces several agency appropriations to capture General Fund savings from a rebate given to the state by the State Accident Insurance Fund.
- Appropriates \$30 million General Fund and implements a rebalance of the budget for the Department of Corrections.
- Implements a net-zero rebalance for the Oregon State Police.
- Disappropriates approximately \$1.1 million in Debt Service savings and reduces unneeded expenditure limitation for the Child Support Division in the Department of Justice. Full funding is included for Defense of Criminal Convictions.
- Reduces \$345,000 Other Funds for the Oregon Business Development Department related to a revised project list of Regional Solutions projects.
- Appropriates \$349,000 General Fund to the Department of Housing and Community Services for foreclosure prevention counseling.
- Appropriates \$2.5 million General Fund and increases Other Funds limitation by
  \$2.3 million for the Department of Forestry for emergency fire costs.

- Appropriates \$670,000 General Fund to the Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to purchase an array of fifteen seismometers.
- Increases Other Fund limitation by \$1 million for the Oregon Liquor Control Commission for Measure 91 implementation and to maintain liquor agent's compensation at an average rate of 8.88% of sales.
- Appropriates \$3.5 million General Fund to the Public Defense Services Commission to fund contracted public defense services.
- Disappropriates \$28.7 million General Fund from the Emergency Board.
- Re-authorizes bonding projects for Eastern Oregon University and the Oregon Institute of Technology.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 5543 be amended and reported out do pass, as amended.
