

SB 605

Program Changes

Senate Bill 605 as amended makes the necessary changes in statutes and session laws to support the 2013-15 legislatively approved budget, to clarify the application of statutes for the budget, and to modify provisions relating to the use of funds. Specifically, the measure:

- Repeals requirement that Lottery Funds debt service accounts be fully funded for the fiscal year in the first fiscal quarter of the fiscal year;
- Changes “Mid-Columbia Medical Center” to “Mid-Columbia Health Foundation;”
- Authorizes use of liquor funds for Measure 91 implementation expenses, which are to be repaid with interest; and
- Repeals scheduled transfers of Business Registration Fee revenues to the General Fund.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends Senate Bill 605 be amended and reported out do pass, as amended.
