Regarding: HB 2960

Dear Senator Holvey,

On behalf of the Governor's Commission on Senior Services, I would like to express our support for HB 2960, creating an Oregon Retirement Savings Board within the office of the State Treasurer.

Social Security was never intended to be a person's sole source of income in retirement; however many people rely on it as such. It is clear that people need a way to save for retirement, but about half of Oregonians lack access to an employer-sponsored retirement plan. This bill would create a much-needed voluntary retirement savings plan for those who have no access to a pension or an employer-sponsored retirement plan

The Commission believes that every Oregonian should have access to a voluntary, easy-to-access retirement savings plan, and that these plans should have portability if a person changes employers. Additionally, while we recognize the difficulty in including the *option* for an employer match as part of this plan, Commissioners would fully support such an option if it could be added.
