7 Keizer District 24J school to offer a full-day kindergarten program; and

8 “Whereas McKinley Elementary School has made great technological
9 strides since its first days, from hoisting a white flag outside to indicate the
10 end of recess in 1915 to using tablet computers and interactive whiteboards
11 in 2015; and

12 “Whereas students, teachers, parents and members of the community are
13 gathering on May 29, 2015, in a centennial celebration for McKinley Ele-
14 mentary School, which will include the Spring Garden Party, antique cars,
15 dedication of a new outdoor drinking fountain and recognition of principal
16 Annie Morton; now, therefore,”.
