Measure Description: Authorizes the State Treasurer to issue lottery bonds to finance \$4 million grants from the Oregon Department of Education to school districts to pay for the acquisition, construction or improvement of statutorily defined school-based health centers. Takes effect on passage.

Impact Explanation: The bill authorizes the sale of lottery bonds for the 2015-17 biennium, to finance \$4 million grants from the Oregon Department of Education to school districts to pay for the acquisition, construction or improvement of statutorily defined school-based health centers. While \$4 million will be raised in this biennium for the grant fund, it is not known at this point when individual grants will be distributed.
