**BACKGROUND:** Senate Bill 758 establishes the 13-member Task Force on Students with Intensive Behavioral needs in order to assist educators, school districts, and education service districts in addressing students with intensive behavioral needs. The bill requires the Department of Education to provide staff support to the task force and requires the task force to submit a report no later than September 15, 2016 on its findings.
