To Whom It May Concern,

Trophy Trout Stocking is a critical aspect to economic activity and continued prosperity in Mono County. Mono County purchases \$100,000 worth of Trophy Trout from Desert Springs Trout Farm annually. In addition to the county's financial contributions, approximately \$40,000 is purchased privately and \$74,000 is purchased by the Town of Mammoth Lakes. The \$214,000 worth of fish keeps our waters full of large, healthy, catchable trout that satisfy our anglers for return visitation.

The Town of Mammoth Lakes primarily relies on winter revenue derived from winter sports on and around Mammoth Mountain. Summer revenue is traditionally generated through "outdoor recreation" through camping, hiking and fishing. According to the 2008 Mono County Visitor Profile Study, of the people traveling to Mono County to participate in Outdoor Recreation, 38.7% are specifically coming to fish. That translates to a fishing industry and annual direct spend of \$137,399,191.00 in our towns and communities. During the study period, Desert Springs was providing the vast majority of the trout for the region in a wholesale manner but have recently began performing deliveries directly.

Continuing to ensure our lakes and rivers are full of fish is crucial to attracting and increase angler visitation, spending and economic activity in our region. Desert Springs Trout Farm has been a vital asset to our continued fishing and economic success in Mono County.
