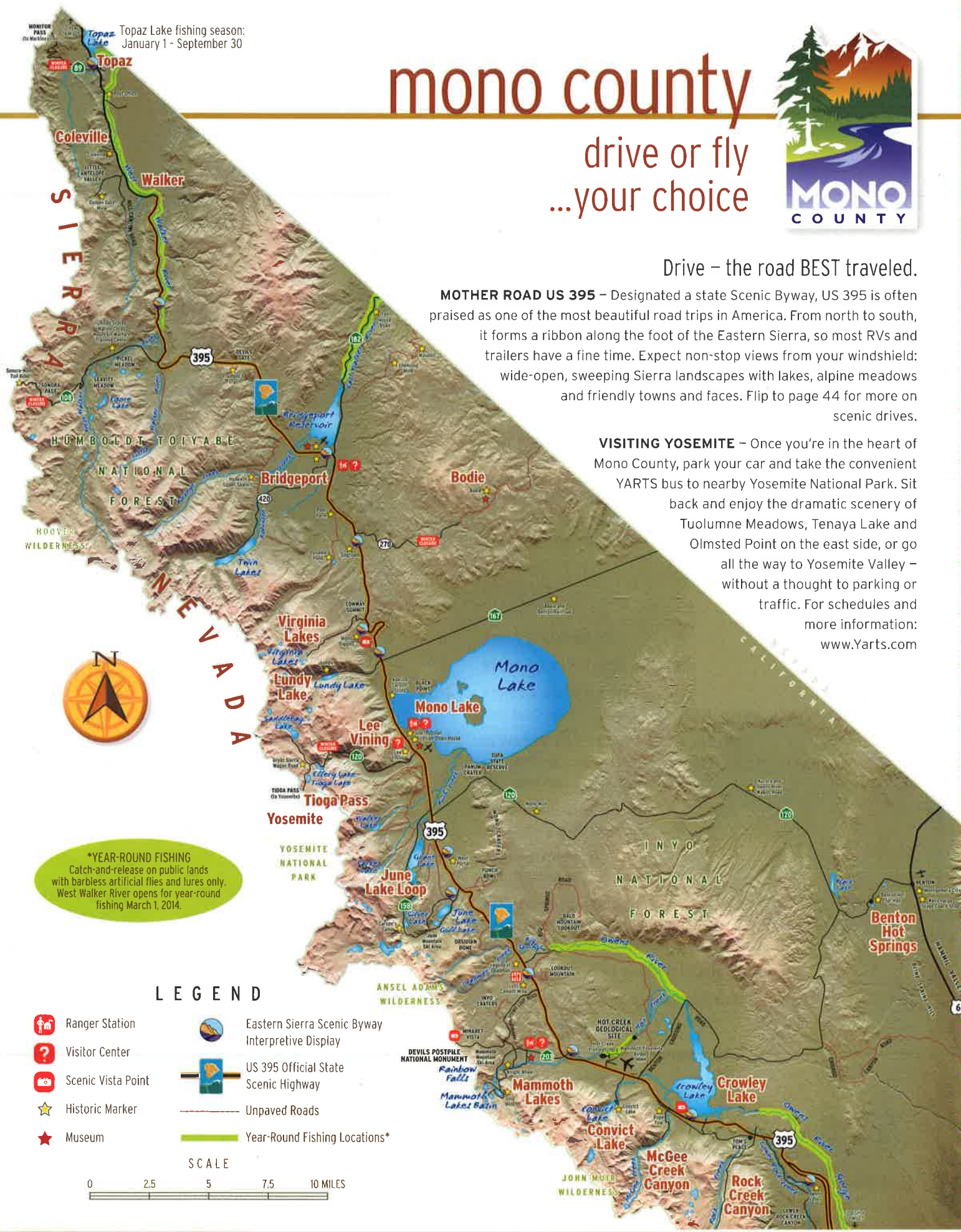

Drive – the road BEST traveled.

MOTHER ROAD US 395 – Designated a state Scenic Byway, US 395 is often praised as one of the most beautiful road trips in America. From north to south, it forms a ribbon along the foot of the Eastern Sierra, so most RVs and trailers have a fine time. Expect non-stop views from your windshield: wide-open, sweeping Sierra landscapes with lakes, alpine meadows and friendly towns and faces. Flip to page 44 for more on scenic drives.

VISITING YOSEMITE – Once you're in the heart of Mono County, park your car and take the convenient YARTS bus to nearby Yosemite National Park. Sit back and enjoy the dramatic scenery of Tuolumne Meadows, Tenaya Lake and Olmsted Point on the east side, or go all the way to Yosemite Valley – without a thought to parking or traffic. Rely on taxis and the free public transportation bus system once you're here (it's fun and easy), or find car rentals (Enterprise, Hertz) at Mammoth Yosemite Airport.

topaz, coleville and walker

A trio of small communities along the naturally beautiful Walker River.

WALKER RIVER – Designated “Wild and Scenic,” the West Walker carries browns and rainbows through its winding bends and rocky troughs. Fishing access is available from various points off US 395 from the last Saturday in April through November 15 every year (fishing license required).

ROAD TRIP AMERICANA – Stay in a classic American motor court or RV resort. Old time roadside burger stops and a lakeside view from the Topaz Casino feel as timeless as the surrounding cottonwood groves.

VISITOR CENTER – Walker Country Store has maps, brochures and wireless Internet. Insider tip: drop off recyclables (plastic bottles and aluminum cans) here to help fund local fish stocking efforts!

WINTER FISHING ON TOPAZ LAKE – A full service marina offers boat rentals, fishing gear and shoreline RV hook-ups for those who like the cooler temperatures of winter fishing, (and of course, all summer long). Success is sweet year-round with trophy size trout on the other end of the line! Fish January 1 - September 30 (fishing license required). Cash prize derby starts New Year's Day!

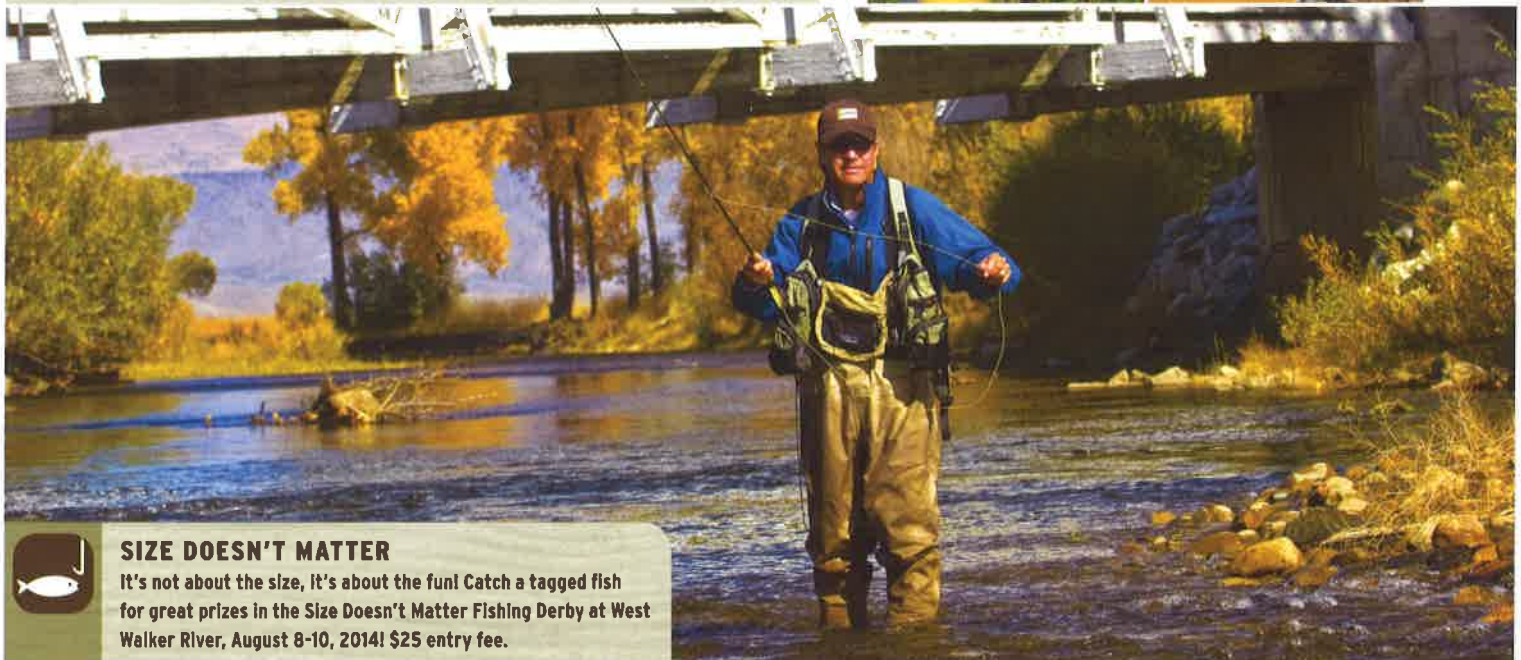
FALL COLOR – From late September through October, the Walker River Canyon, Monitor Pass landscape (Hwy. 89), and Sonora Pass (Hwy. 108) are sights to behold with rich golden, orange and red fall colors.

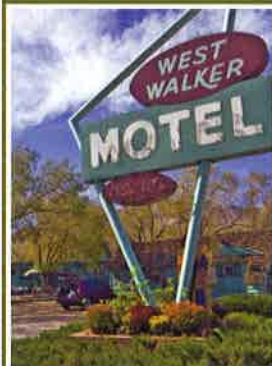

OFF-ROAD AND ATV ADVENTURES

Are you the type who drives Highway 395 only to find yourself wondering how many more exciting roads stretch out beyond in other directions? With hundreds of miles of National Forest land in Northern Mono County, motorists with four-wheel drive SUVs, Jeeps, ATVs, UTVs, and dirt bikes get some of the best vantage points around. Encounter wildflowers, old abandoned gold mines, geologically fascinating areas and breathtaking views, all in a day's ride. Here are some local favorites:

LOBDELL LAKE – Trailhead starts at Bircham Flats Road and continues up through Taylor Canyon. Travel through aspen trees to scenic Lobdell Lake (elevation 9400'), continue along "The Dragon's Back" ridgeline and then down the "Dragon's Tail" which is a narrower, rocky and steeper trail to Jackass Creek and Desert Creek. Stellar views of the Sierra Nevada range to the west.
LENGTH: 60 MILES; INTERMEDIATE TO ADVANCED.

ROCKLIN MINE TRAIL – Trailhead starts at Eastside Road through Risue Canyon to Nye Canyon in the Sweetwater Mountains. With several old mines, stamp mills, and vistas you won't believe, this trail is for advanced riders only. It can take up to 8 hours, so pack lunch, water, and extra fuel.
LENGTH: 90 MILES; MAXIMUM ELEVATION: 8450'; ADVANCED.

QUAINT LITTLE CABIN IN THE WOODS TRAIL – Trailhead starts at Eastside Road. With gorgeous vistas of the Sweetwater Mountains and a good chance of seeing wildlife, this trail/dirt road takes you past a long-abandoned mine to the old Nugent cabin. Be sure to check out the inventive "river water" shower.
LENGTH: 70 MILES; MAXIMUM ELEVATION: 8250' (9100' OPTIONAL); BEGINNER – INTERMEDIATE.

MOUNT PATTERSON TRAIL – Trailhead starts at Bircham Flats Road. After reaching the lovely Lobdell Lake, the trail continues east to begin the climb through stands of trees and steep switchbacks to Mount Patterson (elevation 11,672') where there is a cabin built into the side of the mountain. The views become more spectacular with each mile! The descent through the "moonscape" at the peak heads to the southeast, with stops at Belfort, an old mining area.
LENGTH: 70 MILES ROUND-TRIP; ADVANCED.

WILDFLOWER AND FALL COLOR HIKES

Wild Iris blossoms in late June in the Bridgeport/Twin Lakes area, and July brings a multitude of wildflowers to hiking trails like Robinson Creek. In autumn, Green Creek and Conway Summit are favorites for brilliant fall color.



bridgeport

FISHING FAVORITE – Bridgeport’s trout fishing is legendary. RV-friendly Bridgeport Reservoir, north of town, is a favorite among anglers for Opener and especially during the early part of the season. Fly fishermen love Robinson and Buckeye Creeks that curve through meadowlands and rolling foothills of scenic wilderness. Fishing season is the last Saturday in April through November 15 every year, but it’s so good here, it stays on minds all year ‘round – and the nearby East Walker River is open for winter catch-and-release fishing. As of March 1, 2014, so is the West Walker! (See page 46 for regulations).

TRAVERTINE & BUCKEYE HOT SPRINGS – Part of the reason the Eastern Sierra made *Lonely Planet’s* list for the *Top 10 US Destinations to Visit in 2013!* Soak in stunning views of the Sierra in 100-degree natural pools. For maps on how to get to these natural, scenic hot springs, go to MonoCounty.org/Bridgeport.

WINTER BACKCOUNTRY – Adventurous snow-seekers can explore Bridgeport Winter Recreation Area, a large 7,000-acre section of the Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest open to experienced snowmobilers, cross-country skiers and snowshoers. Access is on Sonora Pass (Hwy. 108). Permits are free but mandatory with the Bridgeport Ranger District (760-932-7070; MonoCounty.org/Winter-Activities).

HISTORY – Whether you stay at the Hunewill Guest Ranch, a working cattle ranch which has been in operation for over 100 years, or one of the historic motels on Main Street, Bridgeport’s past is everywhere. The beautiful Bridgeport Courthouse is the second-oldest in continuous use in California, and the Mono County Museum houses exhibits inside the 1880 schoolhouse. The Old West really comes alive during traditional Fourth of July festivities, as well as Labor Day weekend, when the annual “Founder’s Day” event celebrates the town’s beginnings with bluegrass music, hay wagon rides, ranch roping, and much more.

twin lakes

Backed by the jagged spires of the Sawtooth range and about 13 scenic miles from the town of Bridgeport, Twin Lakes is truly picturesque – and an angler’s paradise. The largest German brown trout caught in California – a whopping 26.8 pounds – was hooked here! Both Lower and Upper Twin Lakes offer a wide range of services for visitors, including boat rentals, campgrounds, cabins, restaurants, general stores, tackle shops and a list of local fishing guides. For hikers, the Robinson Creek Trail, 8 miles round-trip, is a favorite hike, with its sweeping views of snow-capped peaks and pristine Barney Lake.

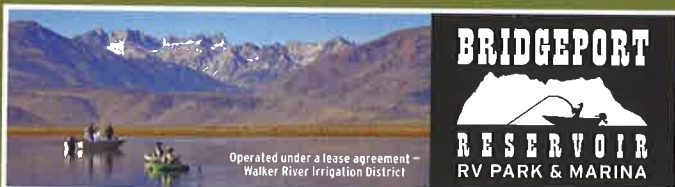



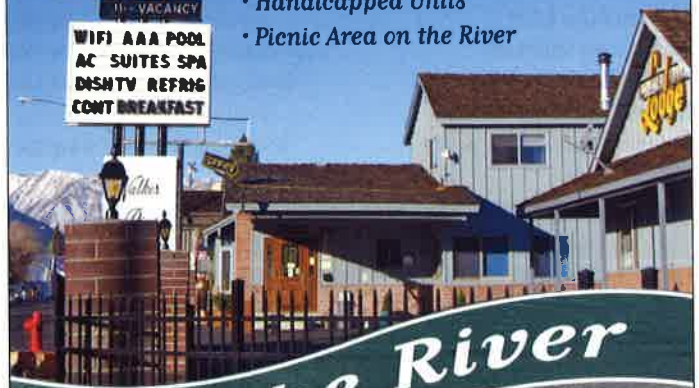

BODIE STATE HISTORIC PARK – The memory of California's wild gold mining days comes alive on Bodie's long-abandoned dirt streets with 170 of the town's relic buildings, preserved in a state of "arrested decay." From 1877 to 1888, Bodie was a bustling town with more than 10,000 residents and produced more than \$35 million in gold and silver.

SUPERSTITIOUS? – Even if you're not, be sure to leave every nail, rock and stick exactly as you see it. The Bodie Museum has a huge collection of letters from remorseful visitors who have reported experiencing a string of bad luck events after helping themselves to Bodie "souvenirs"!

HOW TO GET TO BODIE – Bodie is located 13 miles off US 395 (the last three miles are unpaved and can be rough) south of Bridgeport on State Route 270. The public is welcome to explore, photograph and relive the past during daylight hours, year-round. (Entrance fee; 760-647-6445.)

MUSEUM TOUR TIP – For a small fee, tours of the interior of the Stamp Mill are offered twice daily throughout the summer months. Sign up at the Museum.

FISH AND HIKE LUNDY CANYON AND VIRGINIA LAKES, QUINTESSENTIAL HIGH SIERRA – *Sunset Magazine* ranked Lundy Canyon and the Eastern Sierra as one of the top five hiking spots for fall colors in the West. Depending on the time of year, hikers will see waterfalls, wildflowers and even beaver dams in these lush, undeveloped canyonlands.

Virginia Lakes, at the foot of 12,374-foot Dunderberg Peak, is a favorite area for trout fishing. At the top of Conway Summit, Big and Little Virginia Lakes and Trumbull Lake are among the highest road-accessible lakes in the region. Virginia Lakes Resort offers cabins, boat rentals, a general store, and cozy café with home-style cooking and fresh baked pies. Many hike-in lakes are accessible from the trailhead at Big Virginia Lake and nearby pack station, Virginia Lakes Pack Outfit provides day trips and overnight horseback riding excursions farther into the high alpine. Camping is available at both Lundy Lake and Virginia Lakes.

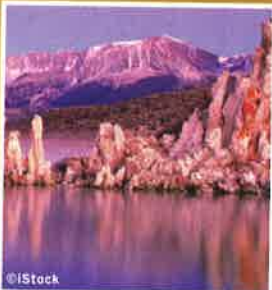

BIRDWATCHING PARADISE – Did you know that Mono Lake is one of the most studied bird sanctuaries in North America? Approximately 300 species have been identified. Witness migratory gulls and phalaropes coming to feast on brine shrimp and alkali flies during bird walks, offered regularly in summer. NATURAL HOT SPRINGS – From US 395, turn east on Benton Crossing Road (at the green church) to one of the oldest surviving towns in Mono County. Established in 1862, Benton once thrived as a silver and gold mining town with 5,000 residents and a Wells Fargo stagecoach station. Travelers still visit the sleepy one-road town for the bed & breakfast or to camp and, of course, to soak in the natural hot springs. It's worth an overnight visit just to see the starry night sky in Benton, which is completely unmarred by artificial lights.

CHALFANT – “Conveniently located in the middle of nowhere,” the Chalfant Mercantile Store serves its local community and welcomes travelers needing to stretch their legs, fuel up, and enjoy a delicious bite to eat.

DON'T LET THE NAME DECEIVE YOU – Convict Lake is one of the most romantic and family friendly sites in the area for both recreation and fine dining. Under the watchful presence of Mount Morrison, the lake is bordered by an easy three-mile hike that is perfect for families. Its deep blue waters have become popular with selective fishermen who enjoy a well-stocked lake. On shore, the year-round resort features a renowned restaurant serving country French fare and elegant preparations of Mono County's famous Alpers trout. Convict Lake is also a signature backdrop to the High Sierra's most scenic weddings. Additional amenities include cabins, an 88-site campground, marina, boat rentals, general store and pack station. Convict Lake fishing derbies take place all spring and fall.

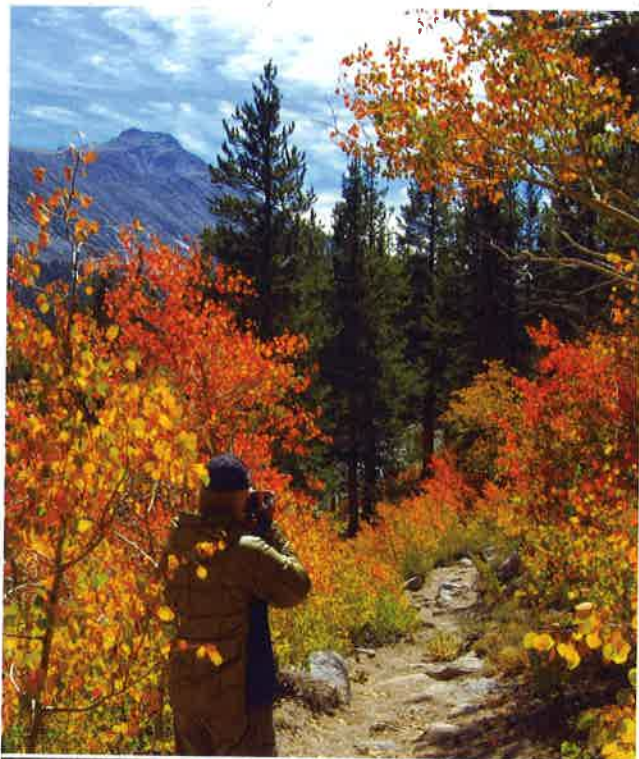

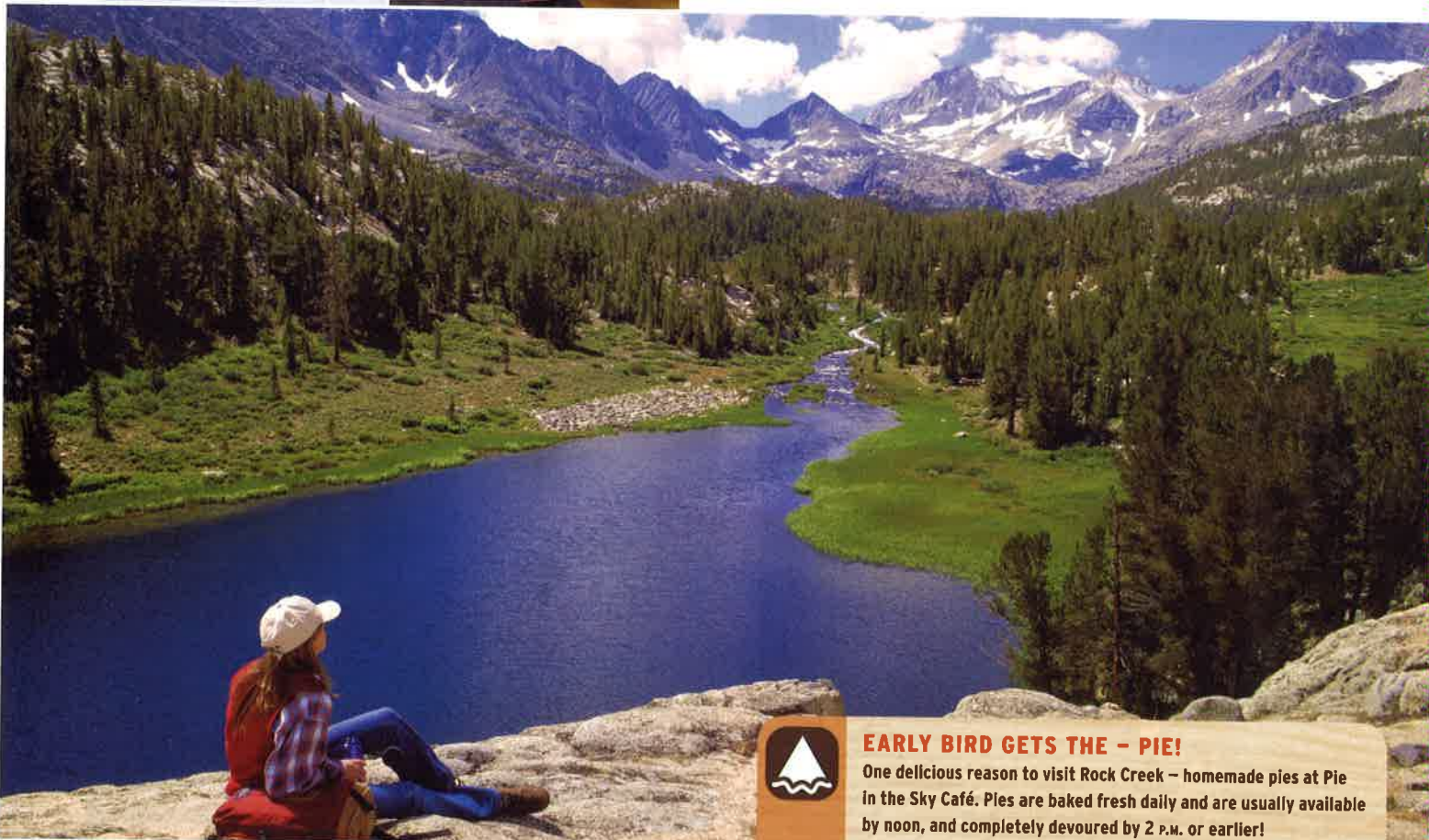
PRISTINE GLACIER VALLEY – Accessed by a 10-mile paved road that ascends through glacier-carved canyon walls, Rock Creek provides loads of outdoor fun in a pristine setting. The large wilderness area is home to three lodge-resorts, a pack station, numerous trailheads, fishing spots, and campgrounds.

In summer, Rock Creek is popular with hikers, horseback riders, bicyclists and rock climbers. At the end of Rock Creek Road is one of the area's most beloved hiking trails, Little Lakes Valley, which follows the creek from one lake to another, mile after gentle mile.

TOM'S PLACE – The gateway to Rock Creek, Tom's Place has been an Eastern Sierra mainstay since 1917. Originally built and owned by Hans Lof, Tom's Place has a classic general store, restaurant, bar and rustic cabins – not to mention friendly staff with the inside line on local fishing.

AUTUMN MAGIC – Fall color season is incredibly vibrant in Rock Creek Canyon, but it's kind of the like the homemade pies at Pie in the Sky Café – blink your eyes and it's gone! Plan a trip in late September/early October to ensure best chances at both.

WINTER PARADISE – With the arrival of snow, the roads in Rock Creek canyon become several miles of groomed cross-country ski trails – a California Sno-Park, in fact – and Rock Creek Lodge becomes a ski-in/ski-out overnight destination for those craving a real "get-away-from-it-all" winter retreat. The lodge also offers a unique Adventure Dining experience for day visitors, too. Park your car at East Fork, ski or snowshoe (or take the snowmobile taxi) to the lodge for a delicious prix-fix dinner, then return by the light of the moon!

top 6 places for fall color



1 EARLY SEASON COLORS: ROCK CREEK CANYON
Carved deep into the landscape by glaciers, this paved, two-lane canyon route is lined with dense aspen groves for nine miles that are often the first of the season to turn bright orange and yellow.

2 THE CLASSICS: MCGEE CREEK CANYON & CONVICT LAKE
For a classic fall color hike, stretch your legs on the McGee Creek trail. Brilliant colors line the alpine creek in this dramatic canyon. Nearby Convict Lake is a signature high alpine lake rimmed with glowing aspens.

3 FISHERMAN'S PARADISE: JUNE LAKE LOOP
A treat any time of year but famed for fall, June Lake is home to four lakes that are visible from the road as you drive through the charming village and along the tree-bordered route, known as the Loop (Hwy. 158).

4 FAMOUS FOR FALL: LUNDY CANYON
Lundy Canyon consistently puts on a fantastic fall color display along the scenic, paved road to Lundy Lake, and then along the dirt road to the beaver ponds and hiking trail.

5 THE PHOTO OP: CONWAY SUMMIT & VIRGINIA LAKES
When Conway Summit is observed by motorists on US 395, the impact of layers upon layers of fall colors means a definite stop to take photos. Find more fall color, fishing spots and hikes by taking Virginia Lakes Road, at the top of Conway Summit.

6 GOLDEN RIVER BANKS: WEST WALKER RIVER AND SONORA PASS
Fragrant pines, towering willows and 100-year-old cottonwood line the banks of the Wild & Scenic West Walker River, which runs parallel to US 395. Rolling sage-covered hills and vibrant meadows stretch along the heights of winding Sonora Pass.

top 8 hiking trails

Miles and miles of hiking trails for all abilities make Mono County a paradise for those who love to “walk with nature,” as John Muir did. Here are a few must-hikes, all of which are dog-friendly!

A LITTLE LAKES VALLEY: ROCK CREEK CANYON

Located at the top of Rock Creek Road, this relatively easy trail offers dramatic lake-after-lake views. TIP: For a post-hike treat, drop by Pie In The Sky Café at Rock Creek Lakes Resort for a home-made slice! *Easy to moderate. 5-10 miles round-trip.*

B CONVICT LAKE TRAIL

A gentle hike that winds around one of the most spectacular lakes in the region. TIP: Convict Lake Resort also has a marina with boat and kayak rentals. *Easy. 3-mile loop.*

C CRYSTAL LAKE TRAIL: MAMMOTH LAKES

A series of switchbacks up from Lake George offers exceptional views of Mammoth Lakes Basin. Stop at Crystal Lake or head higher to Mammoth Crest. *Moderate. 4-miles round-trip.*

D PARKER LAKE TRAIL: JUNE LAKE LOOP

From the north end of Hwy. 158 (June Lake Loop), take Parker Lake Road to the trailhead parking. A short hike along the aspen-lined creek has a few switchbacks and offers big rewards with a serene lake tucked at the base of giant mountains. Views of Mono Lake, too. *Easy to moderate. 4 miles, round-trip.*

E TWENTY LAKES BASIN: TIOGA PASS NEAR LEE VINING

On the east side of Tioga Pass, this stunning alpine loop trail linking numerous lakes is located on the north side of Saddlebag Lake. In summer months, a boat taxi is available to take you across to the trailhead. *Moderate. 4.2-mile loop (additional 2-3 miles round-trip if you hike from parking area to trailhead).*

F LUNDY CANYON TRAIL: LEE VINING

One of the most highly regarded hikes in the Eastern Sierra for wildflowers, fall colors, waterfalls, and even a beaver dam, the trailhead is at the end of Lundy Lake Road, off US 395, 7 miles north of Lee Vining. *Moderate. 4-6 miles, round-trip.*

G VIRGINIA LAKES TRAIL: BRIDGEPORT

At the foot of Dunderberg Peak, this trail climbs steadily through alpine meadows, and passes numerous lakes and an old mining cabin, finally arriving at Summit Pass with views of Sawtooth Ridge. *Strenuous. 10 miles, round-trip.*

H ROBINSON CREEK TRAIL: BRIDGEPORT

At Twin Lakes and Annett's Mono Village, the trail to Barney Lake winds through evergreen forests, and traverses meadows and aspen groves with sweeping views of dramatic snow-capped peaks. *Moderate. 8-miles round-trip.*

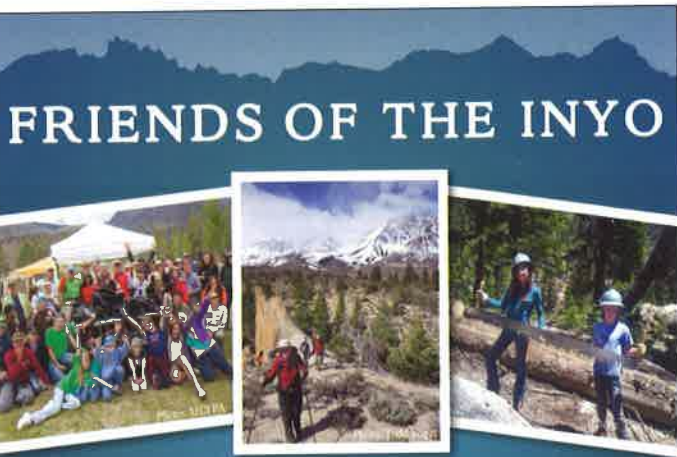
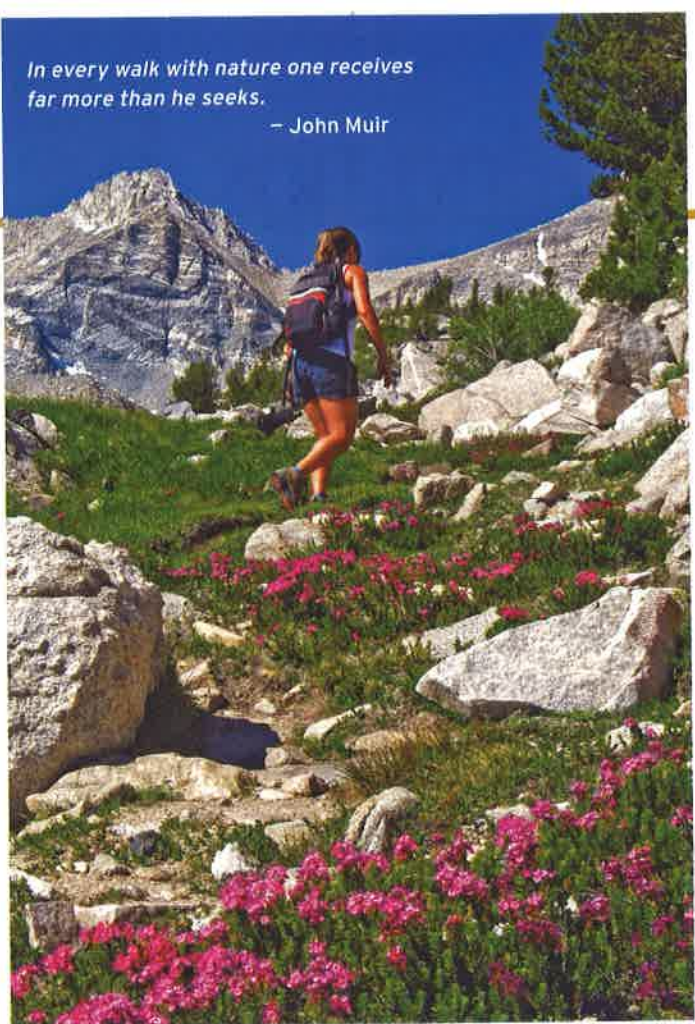

WHERE TO FISH

In Mono County, trout fishing is much more than an activity, it's a passion. Fishing season always begins the last Saturday in April when alpine lakes, streams and rivers begin to thaw, and rainbow, brook, German brown, golden, and native Lahontan cutthroat trout get lively! Mono County invests over \$150,000 annually to supplement trout stocking done by California Department of Fish & Wildlife, the Eastern Sierra Fishing Coalition, and private marinas and resorts. Popular road-accessible fishing spots include:

AREA	LOCATION	FISHING TIPS
TOPAZ LAKE	US 395, north of Topaz/Coleville	Either a CA or NV fishing license works here. Catch rainbows and browns from January 1 to September 30.
WEST WALKER RIVER*	US 395, Walker/Coleville/Topaz	Designated a Wild and Scenic River, the West Walker is open for year-round fishing, beginning March 1, 2014, and subject to year-round fishing regulations.
LITTLE WALKER RIVER	US 395, South of Walker/Coleville	Little Walker River runs from Little Walker Campground to the opening of the West Walker River and is popular with fly fishing anglers. Stocked with rainbows and browns.
BRIDGEPORT RESERVOIR AND EAST WALKER RIVER*	Hwy 182, North of Bridgeport	Anglers come from all over the country each year to try their luck against wily browns, rainbows, cutthroat and Sacramento perch. The East Walker is open for year-round fishing – see regulations below.
TWIN LAKES	Twin Lakes Road, Bridgeport	About 13 miles from Bridgeport, this is a family favorite with excellent camping and fishing on two pristine lakes beneath Sawtooth Ridge.
VIRGINIA LAKES	Virginia Lakes Road	At the top of Conway Summit, south of Bridgeport, these picture-perfect lakes west of US 395 are stocked regularly with rainbows and browns.
LUNDY LAKE	Lundy Lake Road	North of Lee Vining, west of US 395, follow Lundy Lake road to a good-sized lake and lots of rainbow, brown and brook trout.

JUNE LAKE LOOP	Hwy 158 / June Lake Loop	Four lakes – June, Gull, Silver, and Grant – all within a 15-mile stretch are loaded with Alpers, rainbow, and brown trout.
LOWER RUSH CREEK	Hwy 158 / June Lake Loop	For experienced fly fishermen, the winding creek yields cautious – but hefty – brown trout.
MAMMOTH LAKES BASIN	Mammoth Lakes	Just minutes above the Town of Mammoth Lakes are several beautiful lakes for float, boat and shore fishing. Rainbows, browns and brookies.
HOT CREEK*	Hot Creek Road	This popular stream, east of Mammoth Lakes, is swimming with trout and is ideal for beginning fly fishing.
SAN JOAQUIN RIVER	Reds Meadow west of Mammoth Lakes	A beautiful area in the backcountry where you can catch rainbows, browns, and brook trout.
CONVICT LAKE	South of Mammoth Lakes off US 395	Catching your limit is common on this big, well-stocked lake. A marina offers boat rentals and Convict Lake Resort hosts derbies every spring and fall.
UPPER OWENS RIVER*	Owens River Road	East of US 395 between June Lake and Bishop, go for big rainbows in spring and browns in fall.
LOWER MCGEE CREEK	Crowley Lake Road	A gentle, meandering stream flowing into Crowley Lake with lots of oxbows, it is an ideal fly fishing stream.
CROWLEY LAKE	South Landing	East of Mammoth Lakes and north of Tom's Place, the rainbow at Crowley grow big off Sacramento perch fry.
ROCK CREEK AND ROCK CREEK LAKE	Rock Creek Road	Stretching from Paradise to Rock Creek Lake, the creek offers countless spots for anglers to drop lines. Rock Creek Lake, heading west at Tom's Place exit, is particularly gorgeous in the fall.

REQUIREMENTS – A California Sport Fishing License is required of anyone over 16. One-day and annual licenses are available online at www.DFG.ca.gov/licensing.

REGULAR FISHING SEASON – April 26 to November 15, 2014.

***WINTER FISHING** – Winter catch-and-release-only fishing is permitted in waters listed with an asterisk; see map on pages 2-3. Topaz Lake's season is Jan. 1 - Sept. 30. Other waters in Mono County – East Walker River, Hot Creek and sections of the Upper Owens River – are open for year-round fishing and are subject to year-round fishing regulations from Nov. 16 – April 25, (catch-and-release/zero limit, using artificial flies or lures only with barbless hooks).

NEW THIS YEAR – Beginning March 1, 2014, the West Walker River from the US 395 bridge just north of Hwy. 108 to the inlet of Topaz Lake is open for winter fishing!

HIKE-IN LAKES – Head up to the higher alpine lakes for solitude, scenery and wild trout. Parker and Little Walker lakes off the June Lake Loop (Hwy. 158) are recommended, as are those along the Little Lakes Valley trail at the end of Rock Creek Road. Other favorite hike-in lakes are around the Twenty Lakes Basin at Saddlebag Lake (Tioga Pass Road/Hwy. 120), as well as Sotcher Lake in Reds Meadow, and Kirman Lake off Sonora Pass/Hwy. 108.

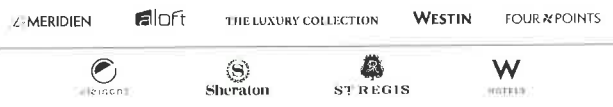

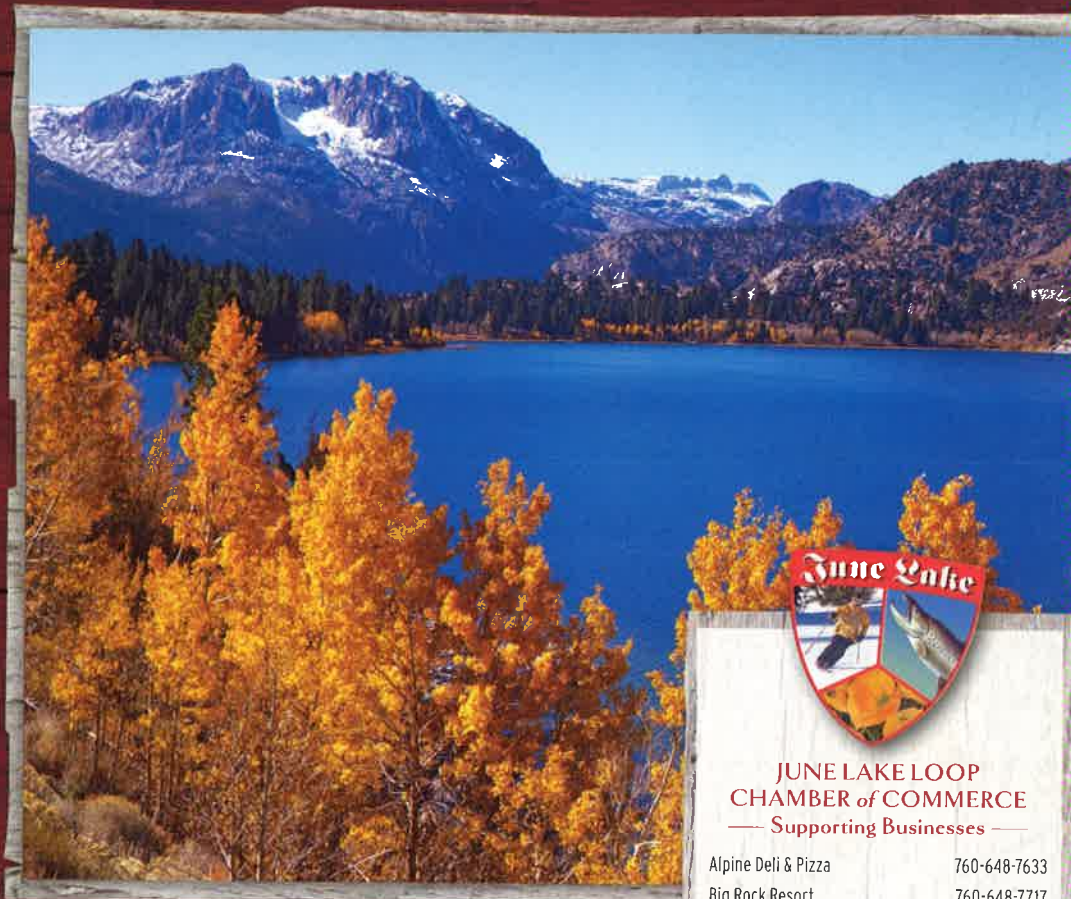
