Lynne,

In a quick calculation, it would double the cost of plates for our district by moving from foam to paper.

For 13-14, we served 317,212 lunch meals. Not all are served on foam plates. We do have schools who was trays. Assuming we did disposable plates for the entire district, moving to a compostable paper plate would cost \$23,790.90 compared to \$11,419.63.

With SFA struggling to meet the financial impact of new food regulations, I don't think this is the time to implement more costly unfunded regulations on our serving trays.
