Measure Description:

Extends sunset for tax credit for rural medical care.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Revenue(DOR)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Tax Credits. The bill extends the sunset date for the rural medical care tax credit to January 1, 2022. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is further considered.
