Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This bill would increase fees charged by the Department of Agriculture to distributors of fertilizer, agriculture amendment, agricultural mineral, or lime product and various other related fees. Expenditures will be for grants used for research and development with respect to the interaction of fertilizer, agriculture amendment, agricultural mineral, or lime product with ground water and/or surface water.

The Legislative Fiscal Office believes this measure warrants a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means Committee for consideration of this measure's budgetary impact on the Agency's budget.
