

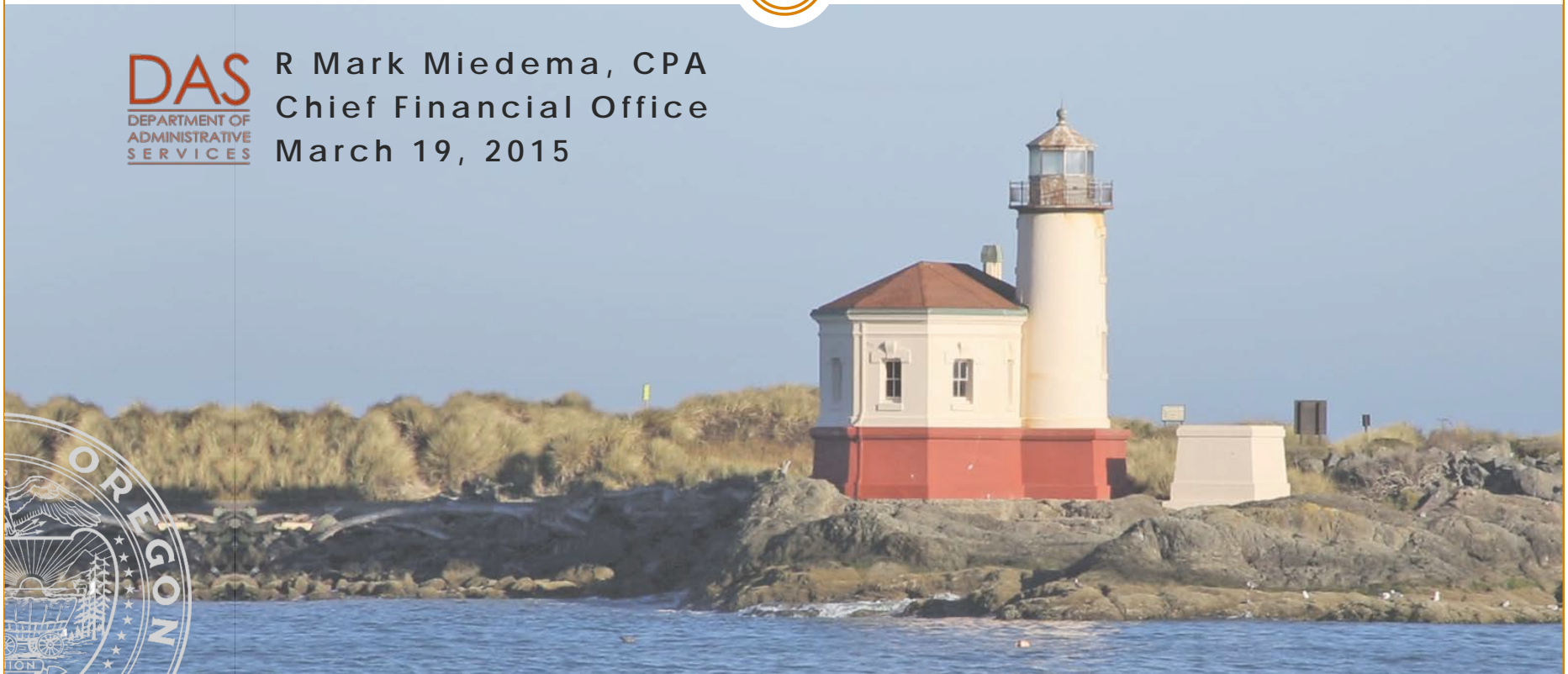

## Agency Overview

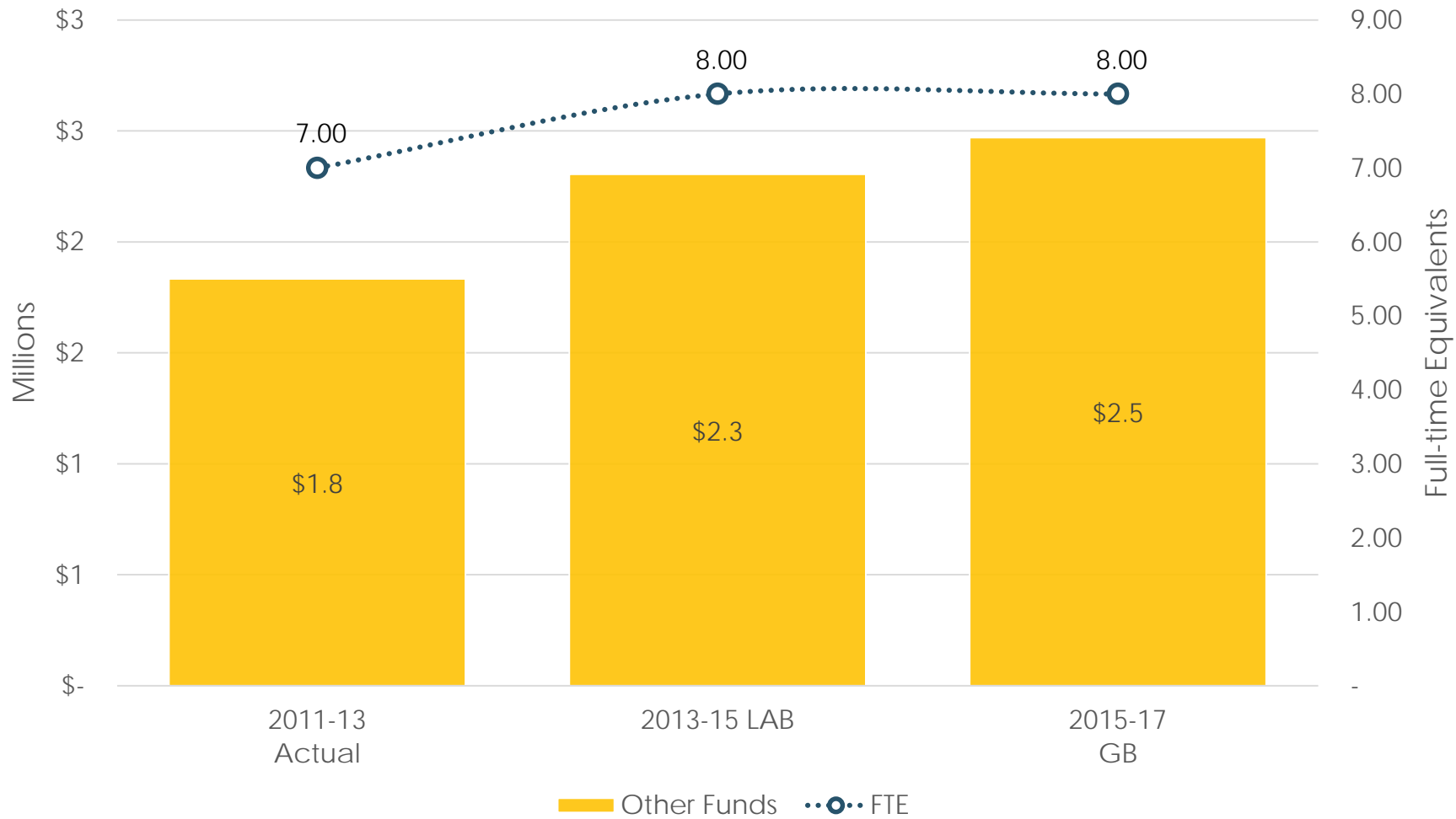

## Expenditure History + 2015-17 Governor's Budget

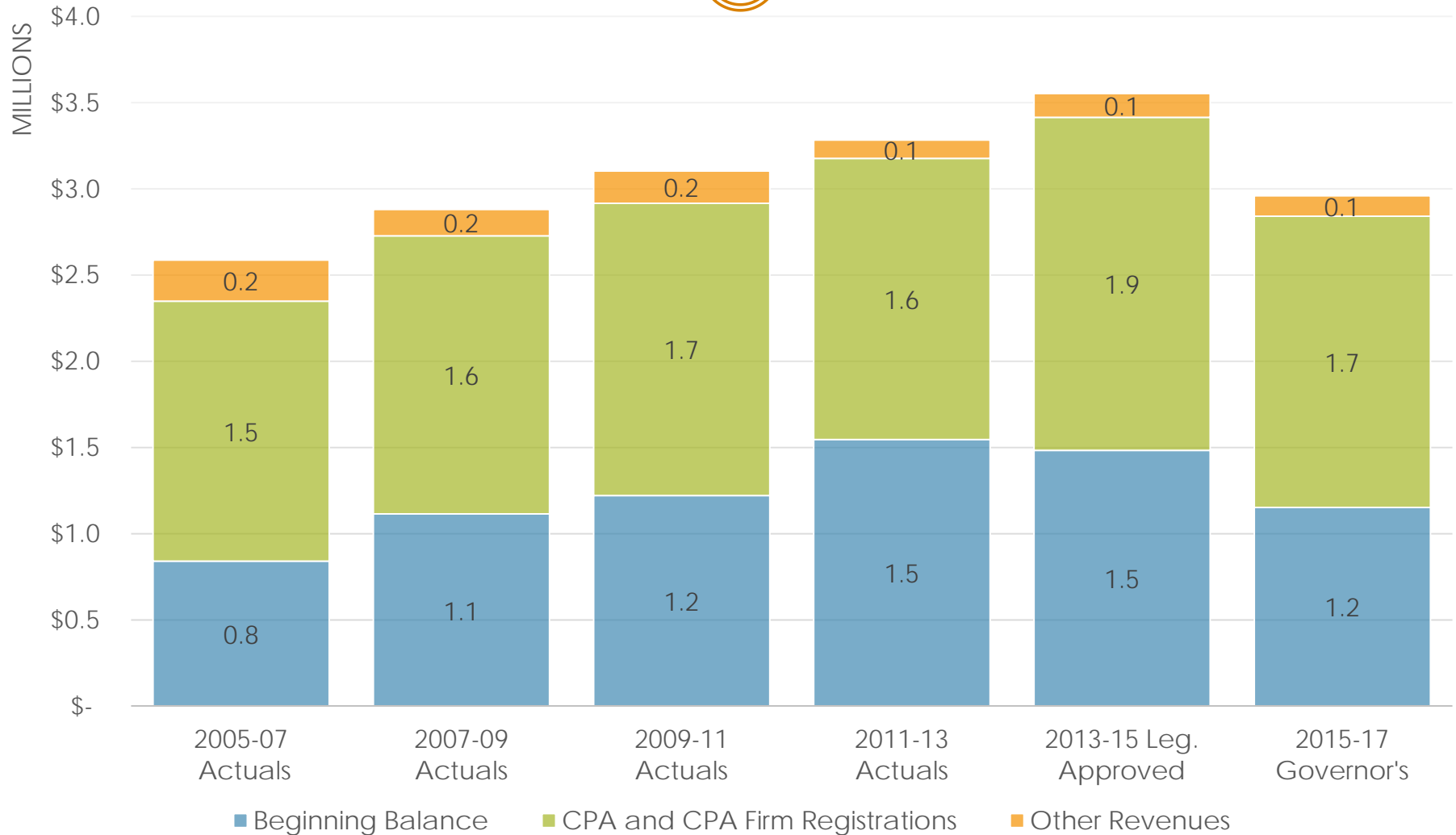

## 2015-17 Governor's Budget

- Investments
  - Package 100 - Continuation of the second Investigator
  - Package 101- Professional Services and Attorney General limitation increase to keep compliance work moving forward and keep the complaint backlog from growing
- There is no fee increase in the Governor's Budget but the Oregon Society of Certified Public Accountants has sponsored Senate Bill 581 to increase renewal fees for CPA's and CPA firms
