**Measure Description:**

Prescribes salary calculation for substitute teachers in school district that has class schedule based on four-day week.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Education, School Districts

**Summary of Expenditure Impact:**

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have a minimal expenditure impact on the Oregon Department of Education. The bill may increase costs for schools with class schedules based on a four-day week, by increasing the daily salary paid to substitute teachers. One school district with a four-day week schedule and 2,300 Average Daily Membership (ADMr), reported an estimated impact of \$110,000 of increased salary costs per biennium.
