As for myself, I am retired from teaching but am still active in schools and agriculture. That being said, we are totally opposed to Senate Bills 206, 264, and 265. The list of reasons for this opposition are countless, but basically the KBRA is an agreement between political entities that has not been settled in the US congress and hopefully never will be, as it is a travesty to what agriculture means in our community.
