These bills will affect Siskiyou County, because
3 of the 4 Klamath hydro-electric dams set for
the removal through the KBRA, which is Not
final, will cause tragic environmental
destruction to the Klamath River. Much
of the Klamath River flows through

Nearly one mile of the Scott River flows through
my property in Scott Valley. If the KBRA
is allowed to go forward it will greatly
affect the Scott River & legal water right
holders, who will lose up to 80% of their CA
