- **Equity Effects of Law and Policy.** *E.g.*, racial impact statements and disproportionate discipline in education

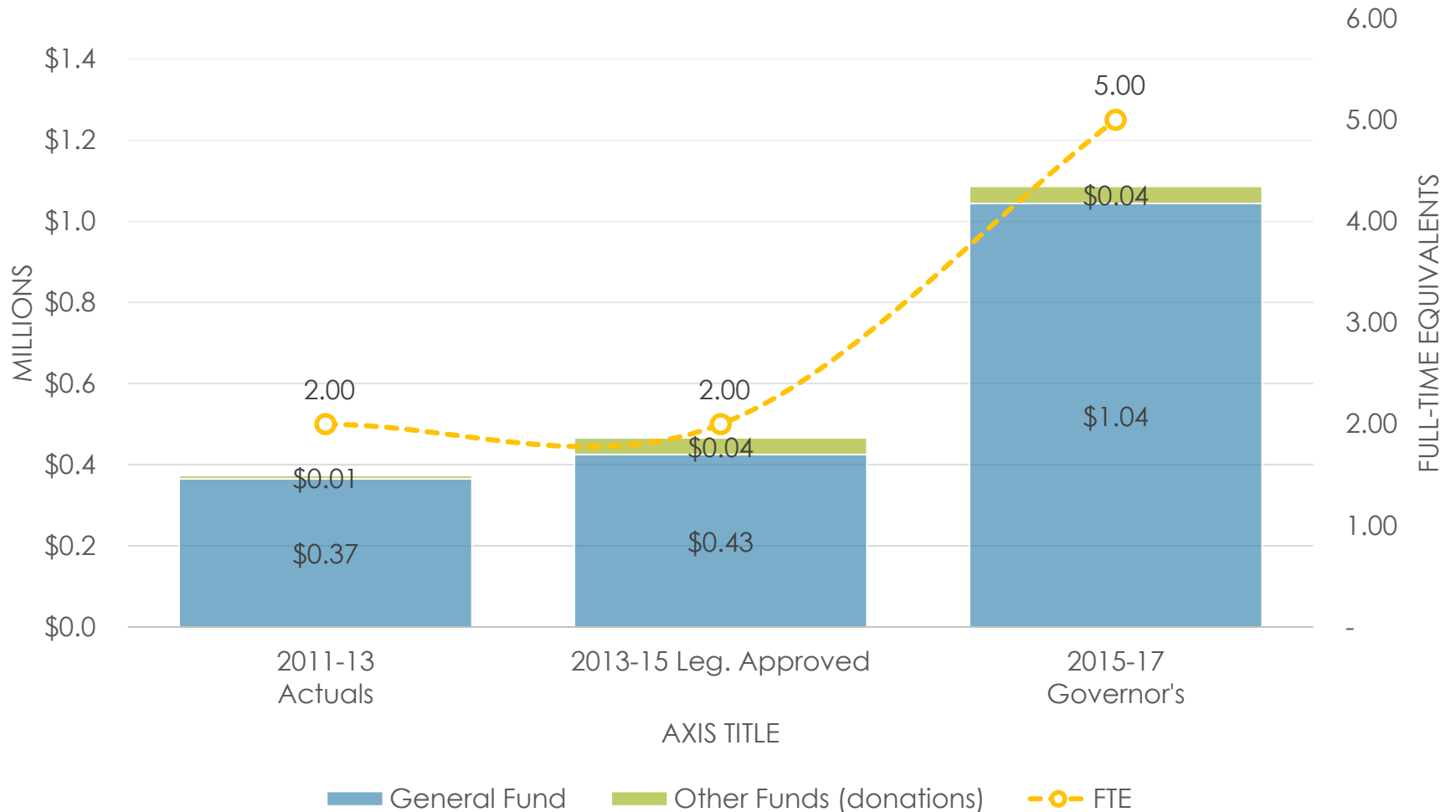
