Measure Description:

Modifies requirements for becoming approved teacher education program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Teacher Standards and Practices Commission

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes the Teacher Education Program Accreditation Account and appropriates \$200,000 General Fund to the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission for transfer to the account. The impact to agency workload as a result of this legislation is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
