I am writing to express my opposition to the proposed gun owner registration bill, SB 941. I believe that this law will only hurt law abiding citizens of the state of Oregon and will not prevent or reduce violent crime. Criminals who are buying guns from other criminals will continue to illegally gain access to firearms. The only people who will obey this law are those who can, and probably already do, own a firearm, or could purchase one from a licensed dealer.
