**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Establishes Federal Funds Commission to study nature and amount of federal funds in state budget, track availability and expenditure of federal funds in state budget, assess risks and effects of reduction in or loss of federal funds, recommend contingency funding plans for federally-funded state programs or services, and annually report to Legislative Assembly.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendments.

**BACKGROUND:** House Bill 3267 establishes a Federal Funds Commission, consisting of five members appointed by the Governor, to study and report to the Legislative Assembly on the nature, availability and amount of federal funds that are included in the state budget. The Commission is directed to assess the risks and effects of any significant reduction in or loss of federal funds, and to recommend contingency funding plans for programs and services.
