**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Imposes one-year moratorium on adoption, amendment or repeal of any administrative rule that has fiscal impact on public of \$50,000 or more. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendments.

**BACKGROUND:** Oregon law requires a state agency to provide public notice to interested parties before the agency takes action on proposed rule-making, and specifies the procedural methods for an agency to engage in rule-making.

House Bill 3273 enacts a one-year moratorium prohibiting a state agency from adopting, amending or repealing an administrative rule if the fiscal impact of the action on the public is \$50,000 or more, as estimated by the agency.
