I am a native Oregonian who grew up on a farm on the Luckiamute River near Kings Valley. I set chokers and fell trees during summers to put myself through college. With my siblings, I currently am part of a limited family partnership that sustainably manages 250 acres of timber land. I am also a physician practicing internal medicine in Springfield, Oregon. As a physician, I am concerned about the lack of adequate protection that Oregon's citizens have against potential harmful effects of aerial spraying of private forest land. As a partner in ownership of private forest land, I am aware that current regulations do not adequately protect the public, and I am quite confident that better regulations will not prevent private forest forest forest profitably.

I do not feel that HB 3428, 3429, or 3434 provide needed protection. SB 613 does provide protections and is a much better bill than these three house bills.
