Measure Description:

Creates position of Oregon Women Veterans Coordinator in Department of Veterans' Affairs and specifies responsibilities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Veterans' Affairs

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill creates the Oregon Women Veterans Coordinator position within the Department of Veterans Affairs and has a blank appropriation clause for the 2015-17 biennium. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill; the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
