

To the Judiciary Committee,

SB 525 expands the definition of "domestic violence" well beyond what a reasonable person would consider it to be. This new definition is dangerous, counterproductive and I politely ask that you remove this provision.

As the law currently stands, judges have virtually unlimited discretion to take away a persons Second Amendment rights even if a person has not been accused of or even convicted of a crime. When implemented, the "Dash 1" amendment will correct this unconstitutional action and allow an accused person to seek due process. I urge you to support this amendment if you move this bill forward.
