The definition of "domestic violence" in SB525 is dangerous and can not produce anything positive in stopping any actual crime. It would seem that its only purpose is to grant judges unlimited discretion to take away firearm's rights from people who have not been accused of, let alone convicted of, any crime. This is 'infringement' that the Constitution of the United States forbids. This is illegal, and true patriots will not receive this well.
