To the Judiciary Committee,

SB 525 grossly broadens the definition of "domestic violence" well beyond what any reasonable person would determine it to be. Since this is dangerous, counterproductive and another thinly veiled attempt to further erode the rights of gun owners I urge you to remove this provision.

Right now, judges have virtually unlimited discretion to take away firearm's rights from people who have not been accused of, let alone convicted of, any crime. The proposed "Dash 1" amendment would correct this often abused activity and allow an accused person to seek due process before being treated as convicted criminal. In the event this bill actually moves through, I urge you to support this amendment!
