To the Judiciary Committee,

SB 525 expands the definition of "domestic violence" well beyond what any reasonable person would say. Please remove this phrasing; not only is it obfuscating, it is dangerous and counterproductive.

Right now, judges have virtually unlimited discretion to take away firearm's rights from people who have not been accused, let alone convicted of any crime. This runs counter to the US Constitution and the 6th amendment and therefore is null and void. You can avoid a lot of time and money in lawsuits if you strike it.

The proposed "dash 1" amendment would correct this often abused procedure and it would allow any accused person to seek due process of the law (US Constitution, 6th amendment).

I urge you to support these two amendments (-1 & -3) if you move this bill forward.
