Measure Description: Removes the sunset of the law governing the small high school grant.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions): This bill does not change the total revenue available for school districts and education service districts.

Impact Explanation: The Small School District Supplement Fund, commonly known as the small high school grant, is a carve-out off the top and is distributed based on the Average Daily Membership (ADM), to school districts that have statutorily defined small high schools.

The annual grant of \$2.5 million is included and fully accounted for in the co-chairs' budget for the 2015-17 biennium.
