As a general aviation pilot, I know from reading various publications that regarding leaded fuel in aviation gas: The FAA has addressed this issue, unleaded fuel replacements are in testing right now for a mandatory release in 2018, the amount of lead added to the environment by general aviation is very small, not considered a health risk by any state or federal environmental or public health agency, and that GA in Oregon contributes 3.02 BILLION dollars a year to the Oregon economy.

Again, let the fed's take care of this issue as they are currently doing.
