

Water Resources Department Agency Overview




The Governor's budget for the Water Resources

- Projects will be across the state and will focus on water resource projects that have economic, environmental and community benefits






Water Resources Department 2015 - 17 Governor's Budget





Investments

- Entering decisions on submitted water rights transactions more efficiently (Pkg 101 and 104 statewide and Klamath)
- Integrated Water Resources Initiative
 - Investments in technical and professional staff
 - Lottery bond proceeds to be used for place-based planning grants, project feasibility grants, and projects
 - General Obligation Bond proceeds for water projects.
