- Replace aging kitchen equipment including all cook line, washing and delivery units to improve quality and delivery of food, and comply with newer cleanable surfaces requirements
- · Update resident rooms and bathrooms to provide a more home like setting
- Replace outdated equipment in rehabilitation and therapy area and remodel space for efficiency
- · Update wing dining area nutrition centers to accommodate food prep and delivery
- Remodel nurse stations to accommodate modern computer needs and call systems
- Replace mismatched, dated and worn vinyl composite flooring
- · Repainting, new handrails and wall protection is needed throughout the entire facility
- Replacement of worn 18 year old furniture and equipment is needed
- Upgrade to the interior lighting as required by the State of Oregon and update information technology cable to accommodate electronic health records and communication band width requirements
- Additional storage area is needed to store resident belongings and supplies for operation

FEDERAL GRANT AND LEGISLATIVE ACTION REQUEST

The Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA) requests approval to apply for a United States Department of Veterans Affairs (USDVA) State Home Construction Grant (CFDA: 64.005) in order to facilitate physical plant upgrades to the Oregon Veterans' Home in The Dalles.

In addition, spending authority of the ODVA share of the project (35%) is requested because USDVA gives a higher priority to projects where matching funds are available and authorized. No General Funds will be used in these projects.

\$2,805,303 Federal 65% \$1,510,547 State 35%

PROCESS AND TIMELINE

April 15, 2015 The deadline for filing USDVA State Home Construction Grant.

June/July 2015 USDVA notification of preliminary placement on the construction priority list within 60 to 90 days.

August 2015 Submission of additional grant materials to the USDVA.

Spring 2016 or 2017 Depending on the final placement on the priority list, it is likely that the proposed improvements and

expenditures would commence in the spring of either 2016 or 2017.
