I am writing to be placed in testimony regarding the 78th Oregon Legislative Assembly 2015
Regular Session Senate Bill 941.

This bill violates the rights of gun owners, and goes too far both in demanding that private gun
sales must transact through a dealer. The penalties listed - "Punishes violation by maximum of
one

year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both, or maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000
fine, or both, for second or subsequent offense . . . " is not warranted, and quite excessive. As
well the additional bureaucracy described in this Bill at best will be massively inefficient, and at
worst flagrant violation of privacy to gun owners.

I do not agree that this will increase safety, and you can not protect the rights of some by
violating the rights of others.

I respectfully support a Do NOT Pass Committee Action on the 78th Oregon Legislative

Dear Judiciary Committee Counsel Rhoades,

I am writing to be placed in testimony regarding the 78th Oregon Legislative Assembly 2015 Regular Session Senate Bill 941 regarding the work session on 4/2/15.

This bill violates the rights of gun owners, and goes too far both in demanding that private gun sales must transact through a dealer. The penalties listed - "Punishes violation by maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both, or maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both, for second or subsequent offense . . ." is not warranted, and quite excessive. As well the additional bureaucracy described in this Bill at best will be massively inefficient, and at worst flagrant violation of privacy to gun owners.
