Chair Roblan, and members of the committee, my name is Anna Wheeler and I have two sons attending Hope Chinese Charter School in Beaverton.

I am writing to request your support for SB 819. This increased support will go a long way toward fostering equanimity between public schools and publicly funded charter schools. The disparity that currently exists does a disservice to our children through limiting access to educational materials, limiting the quality of facilities, and limiting access to ongoing training. As a Chinese immersion school, HCCS is filling a critical gap in the educational and cultural landscape of Washington county. The longterm impact of such a school is increased cultural awareness, expanded business skills via Mandarin fluency, and enhanced critical thinking skills.
