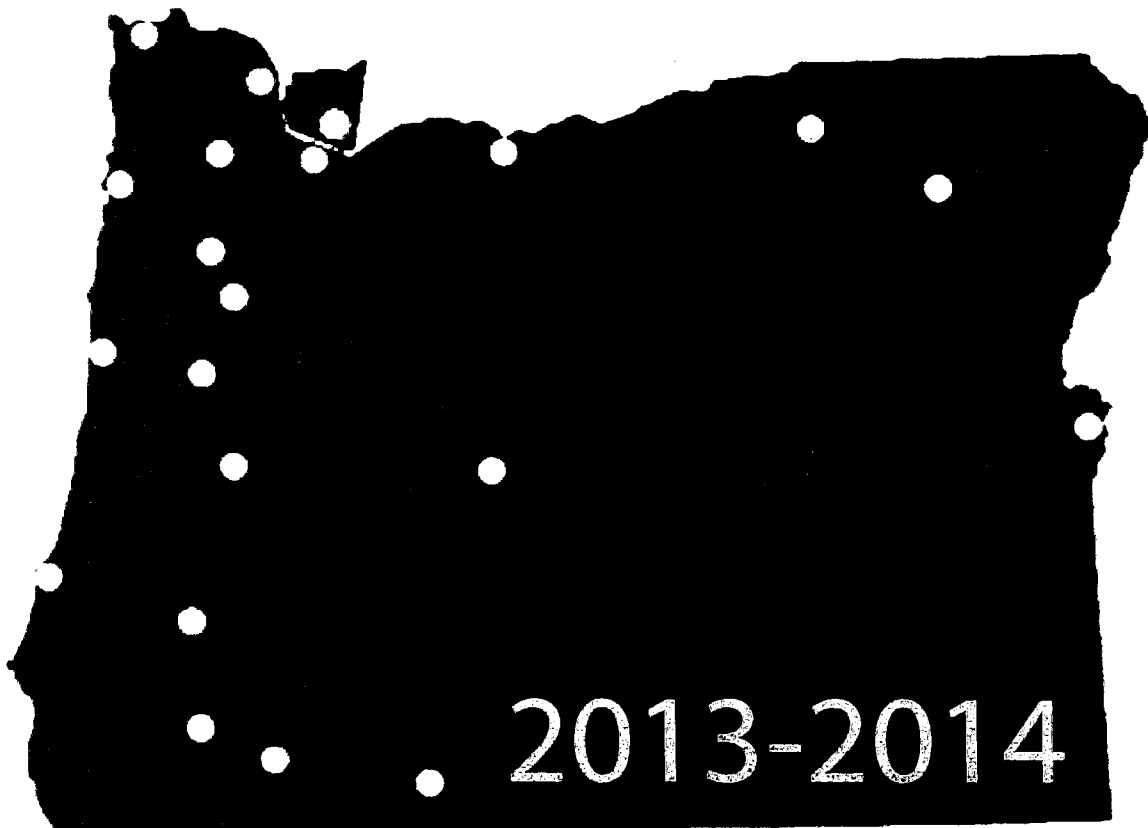

INTRODUCTION

Oregon Food Bank is dedicated to delivering food through 21 Regional Food Banks (RFBs) working in partnership with over 960 Partner Agencies (PAs). Through Network collaboration we are able to leverage our collective resources, equitably distribute food throughout our service area and enhance our capacity to serve food insecure people throughout Oregon and Clark County, WA.

The following profiles provide a quick snapshot of the 21 OFB Network RFBs. These organizations represent great variety: Six are independent non-profits, ten operate through Community Action Programs, one is a program of a CAP subcontractor, and four are operated by OFB. While most have adequate storage and transportation, others have very limited facilities.

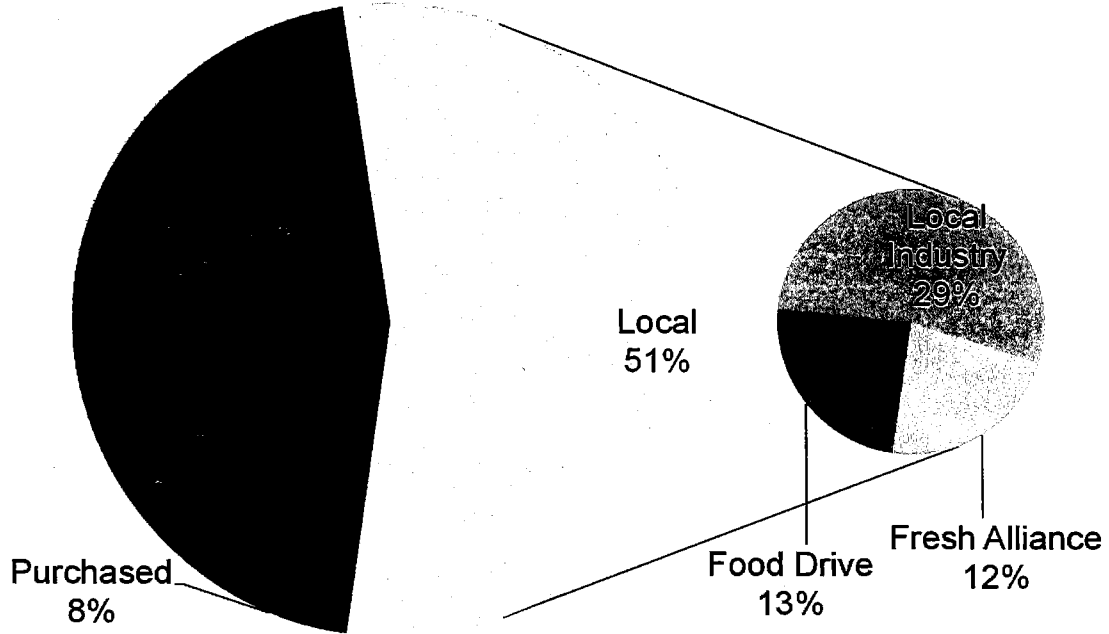
This publication shows the strength and diversity of the total Network. We collect food from a variety of sources, much of it coming into the stream through the very Partner Agencies that provide direct service to clients. Distribution is based on an allocation system that takes poverty and unemployment figures into account. There are additional opportunities for adding on purchased product and an ever-growing supply of produce, as capacity allows.

The information on these pages paints a picture of collaboration, with each region and every partner contributing in a unique way. It also hints at the incredible feats of logistics necessary to keep the system running day in and day out. As always, our thanks go out to the many unsung heroes, both paid and volunteer, who keep their neighbors fed.



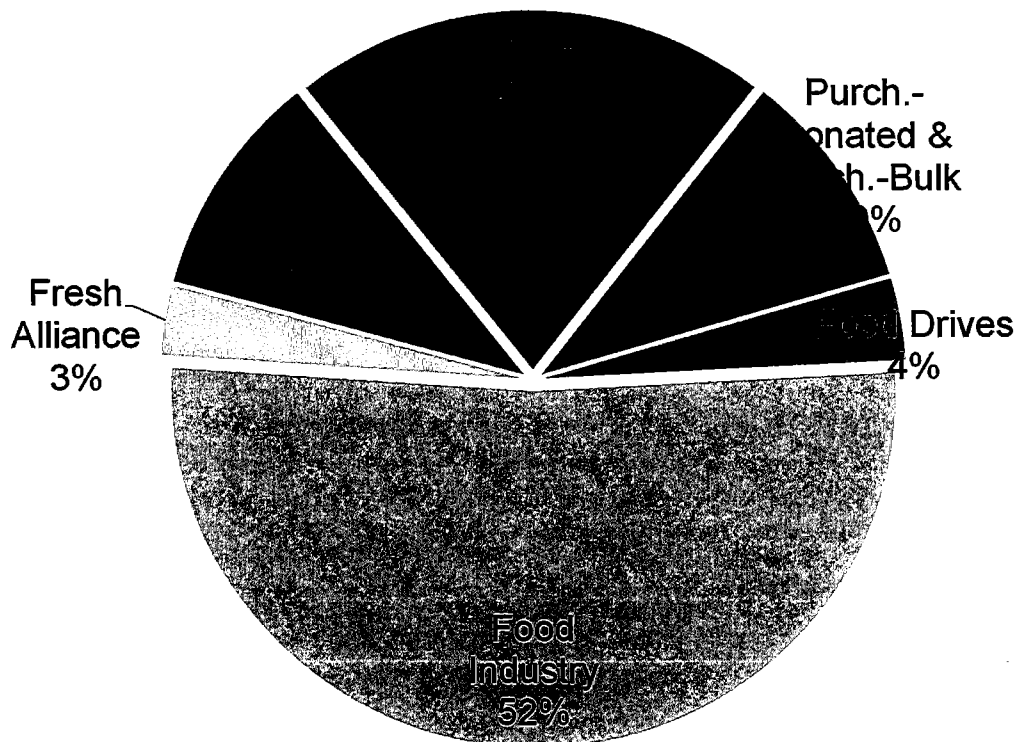
TOTAL NETWORK FOOD RESOURCES

Oregon Food Bank Resources (included above)

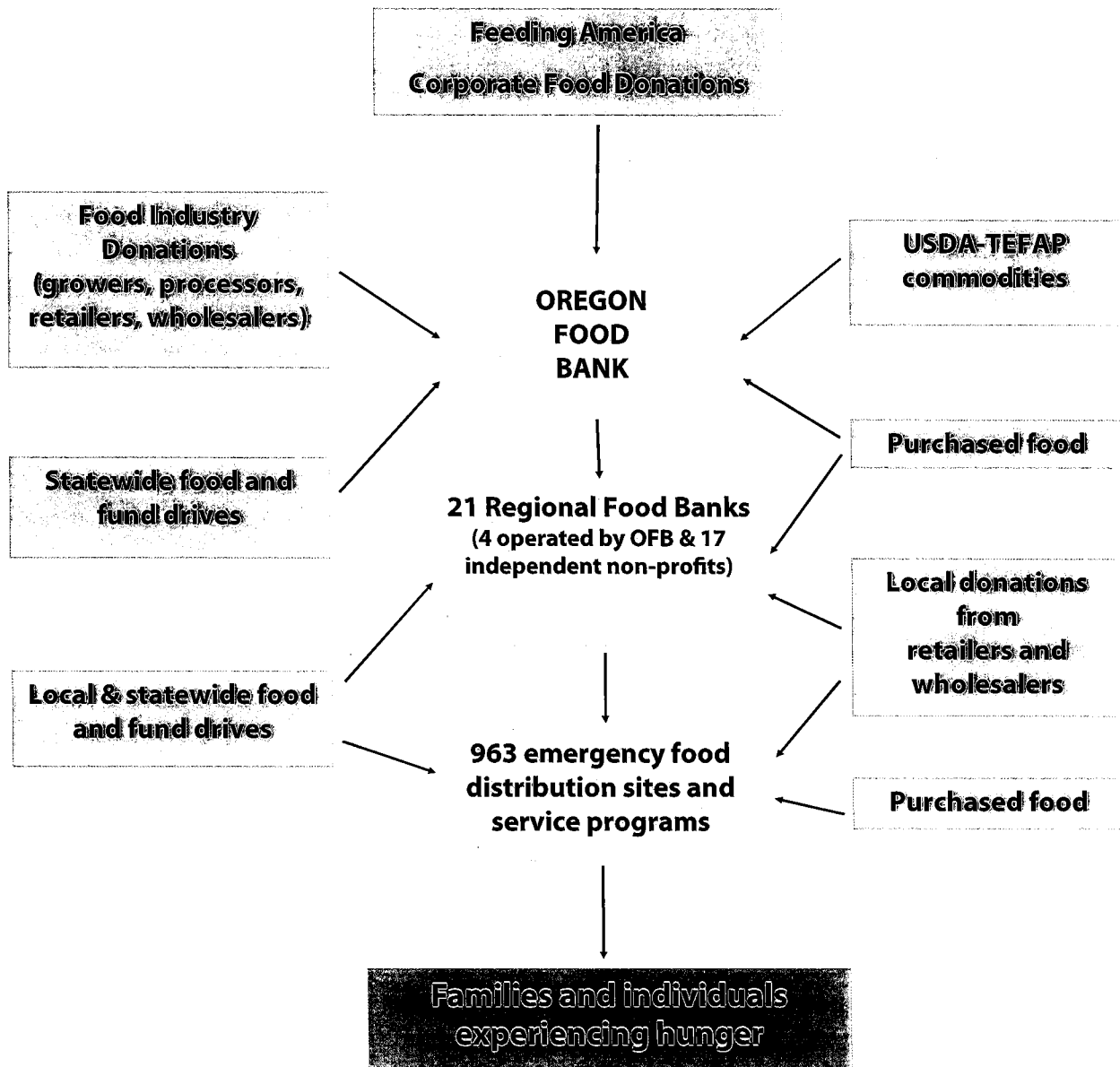
Statewide Warehouse and Branches: Over 44 million pounds of food received in FY2013/14





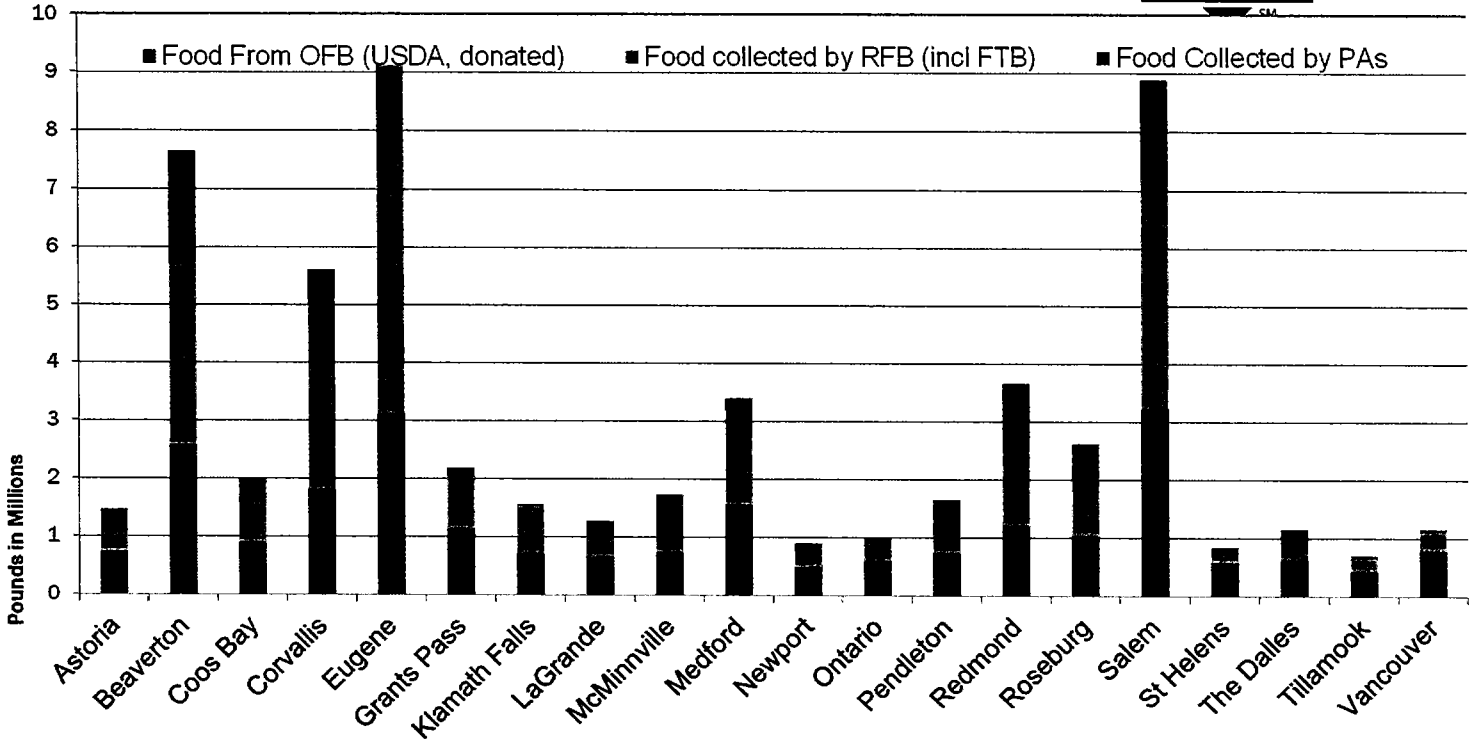
Food Distribution through the Oregon Food Bank Network

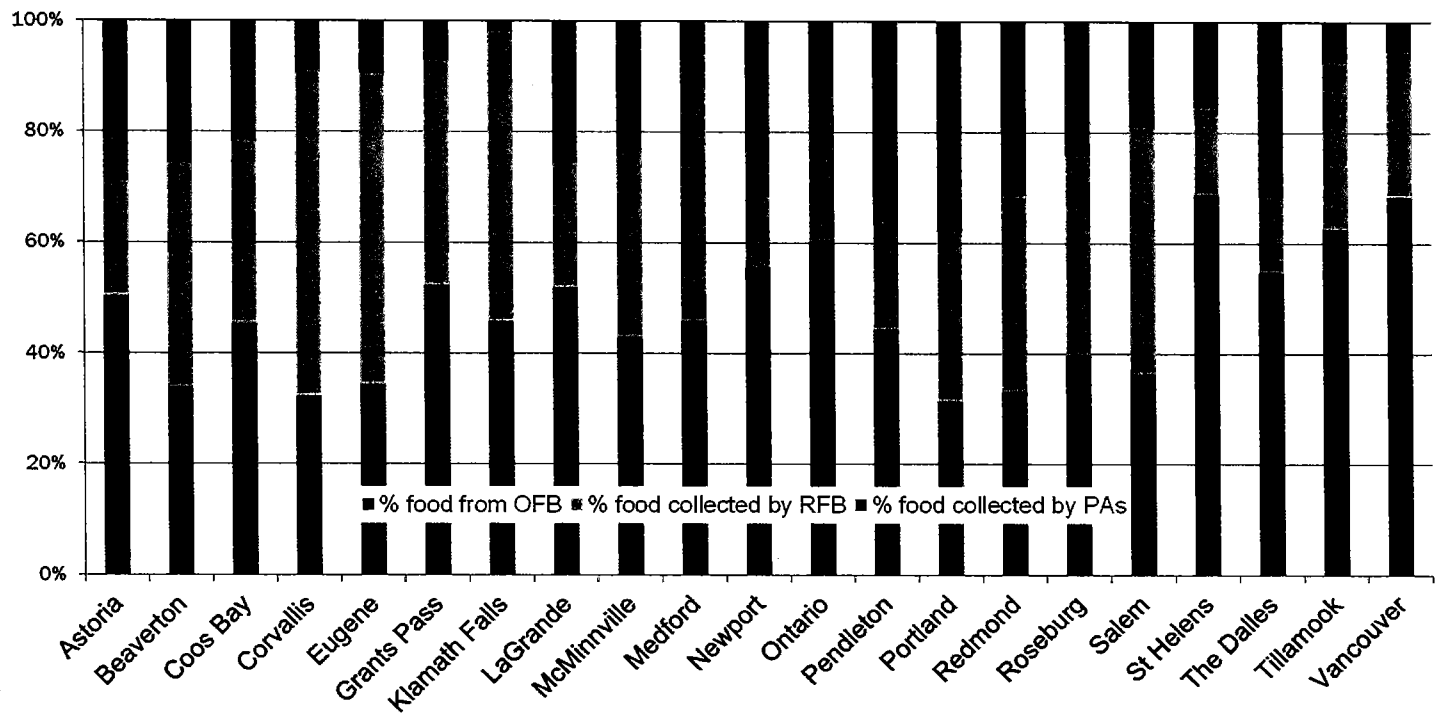
