**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Expands a number of statutory definitions as appropriate, to include persons dishonorably discharged soley on the basis of sexual orientation, where they would otherwise be excluded. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Support for intent of measure, difficulty of actual implementation
- Existing process to re-evaluate discharge
- · Possibility of amendment

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

**BACKGROUND:** Current law generally bars persons dishonorably discharged from military service, from receiving a variety of benefits. Senate Bill 691 creates an exception to this general bar, for those who received a dishonorable discharge based solely on their sexual orientation.
