Dear Chair Vega Pederson and House Energy and Environment Committee,

I am writing in strong support of House Bill 3470 (known as the Climate Stability and Justice Act). Of all of the bills you will be considering at your Committee Hearing on April 14th, HB 3470 is the strongest climate policy and, with a few minor modifications to the current version of the bill, can easily accomplish these key objectives:

- Limits and reduces greenhouse gas emissions with specific targets & timelines
- Requires use of best science to identify key targets
- Provides state agency responsibility and authority
- Gives state agency strategic implementation discretion to meet targets
- Requires five year reporting & strategic adjustments
- Must include full accounting methods for carbon emissions (aka: life cycle analysis)
- Provides mitigation for low income communities
- Integrates existing regulations into single comprehensive program
- Integrates with neighboring state actions for a greater consistency and impact
