As a resident of Wilsonville I attended the public hearing on Senate Bill 716 last Wednesday. I thank you for making this meeting open to the public and the testimony and comments. I heard that this bill would allow Clackamas, Washington, and Multnomah Counties to each designate 150 to 500 acres of land previously designated as rural reserve to be changed to land developable for large lot industrial development. Testimony was given that there is already 8,000 acres of land designated for industrial development in those counties and some of it is in large lots or with some consolidation could be made into large lots. The testimony from leaders in Washington County seemed to indicate they had no interest in converting land in rural reserves to land for industrial use.

I urge you to consider carefully what might be the results of opening up land for industrial development that just four years ago was designated for rural reserve. These boundaries were carefully drawn to protect valuable and irreplaceable farmland and make Oregon a State we and our descendents want to live in and not like California where they have squandered quality of life for the dollar.

I urge you not to schedule further meetings on Senate Bill 716 with the realization it would not serve the people of Oregon but just special interests.
