I think there should be some major re-writing of this bill. This would mean that a granfather/mother who live by themselves would be required to purchase a safe on the possibility their grandchildren may visit. It also does not take into account of juvenile burglery?

A alternative is a state dept offering free or cheap gunlocks to general public. I fully believe this bill should apply ONLY to parents or guardians of children. As responsible gun owners they should prevent unattended children from access to firearms.

Then there is the responsible use of firearms by minors. I grew up on a farm and was very proficient with firearm use. I shot competitive Trap by age of 10. I also used firearms for predators and pests. As I child I remember taking training courses even in the school. A simple class offered in school would be a far greater tool then another law. Knowledge and training are best tools and these could be offered to any who want it.

My final conclusion is this. Don't make arbitrary laws to substitute for common sense. Offer training for those who wish it and offer safety locks for those who need it.
