Aggregate Production for 2011

Sand and gravel mine sites regulated by the Oregon Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI) in the Willamette watershed reported 6,321,452 tons of production for the latest complete production year (2011). This includes production records from 41 sites within the Willamette watershed. No attempt was made to break out production numbers by floodplain, zoning, or soil type.

Sand and gravel mining sites regulated by DOGAMI in the entire state reported 9,010,546 tons of production in 2011. This includes production records from 115 sites.

In 2011, 36% of the sand and gravel operations in the state existed in the Willamette watershed and produced 70% of the total sand and gravel production in the state. In the Willamette watershed 53% of the 2011 aggregate production came from sand and gravel operations.
