Make the current voluntary background check that is set up now in Oregon into a new required law. The new law would require that seller or buyer call in the purchase from where ever their location is at. The law is going to be a success when Oregonians can call from the point of sale. If you make people travel to ffl dealers the law is largely going to be ignored. In order for a law such as this to work it has to be practical.
