Dear Co-Chairs Monroe and Komp,

Thank you for the opportunity to answer questions that arose during the April 8 Higher Education Coordinating Commission's presentation to the Ways and Means Subcommittee on Education.

We would like to clarify the methodology used for our slide regarding projected high school graduation rates by race/ethnicity. The projections use a weighted average of the most recent 4 years of senior graduation rates. The following year looks at the most recent 3 years plus the projected graduation rate for the 4th year, and so on. At about 5 years out, the graduation rate stabilizes and remains constant throughout the rest of the projections. This is consistent for each racial/ethnic category. For completions projected further than 5 years out, variability is due to the projected number of high school seniors. The projection of seniors is generated from collecting enrollment data for each grade and tracking how students have historically moved from grade to grade.

Representative Sprenger inquired regarding the correlation between student debt and time to graduation. As discussed, we provided information in our budget presentation on this topic in slide 11 of our affordability presentation on March 25, and provided further detail in our follow-up letter dated March 26. The average cumulative student debt at graduation for those receiving a bachelor's degree in Oregon in 2013 is \$25,777, and the proportion of graduates with debt is 60%.¹ Table A, which was also included in our March 26 letter, shows the debt load for a cohort of students at Oregon's public university who complete in 4, 5, and 6 years. We have also attached the relevant slide titled "Cost Trends: Debt" from our earlier affordability presentation for your reference.

Co-Chair Monroe requested data on enrollment by resident/nonresident/part time status for each individual university. We have included Chart A and Chart B at the end of this letter containing this information.

Representative Sprenger asked that we provide detailed information on how many high school graduates from each high school in Lane, Grant, Marion and Union counties enrolled in one of Oregon's seven public universities. This information for the graduating class of 2013 at every Oregon high school in the state is attached in a separate document.

Representative Taylor asked that we provide information on graduation rates for Pell recipients overall, resident Pell recipients and those who did not receive financial aid. For the 2007 cohort, the 6-year

graduation rate for Pell recipients was 51.8%, for Oregon resident Pell recipients it was 53.9% and for nonresident Pell recipients it was 39.2%. We are unable to provide data on those receiving no financial aid but the 6-year graduation rate for non-Pell recipients (which includes many taking out loans, or receiving other forms of aid) was 62.9%.

Of additional note, the graduation rate for Oregon Opportunity Grant recipients is higher than any of these graduation rates. Table B at the end of this letter displays Oregon Opportunity Grant recipient graduation rates by institution. Oregon Opportunity Grant recipients graduate at 4.5% greater rate than non-Oregon Opportunity Grant recipients, a category which includes both Pell and non-Pell recipients.

Co-Chair Monroe queried regarding average community college tuition compared to public universities. The average one year 2013 community college tuition and fees is \$4,381 as compared to public university tuition and fees of \$8,202.

Co-Chair Komp asked what constitutes “Other Funds” in Slide 20, which provides information on the relatively share of Education and General Expenses for Oregon’s seven public universities. Other Funds includes Indirect Cost Recoveries which constitute the bulk of “Other Funds.” Indirect Cost Recoveries support the general infrastructure associated with carrying out extramurally funded research such as departmental administration, equipment, operations and maintenance, library and building use, etc. Also included in “Other Funds” are service revenue, state agency transfers-in, investments and debt-service revenue.

We would additionally like to clarify some of the data submitted regarding the differences between Oregon and Washington’s usage of Workforce Development programs in yesterday’s letter. When comparing the federal Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Adult, Dislocated Worker and Youth data between the states of Oregon and Washington, it is important to note that states are allowed to enroll participants at varying points in the registration and eligibility process as long as they are consistent *within* their state. Oregon utilizes a model where every person who enters a WorkSource (WSO) Center is registered into a joint system (Adult and Dislocated Worker) immediately so they can be provided an array of services that they are eligible to receive. Other states choose to wait to enroll customers until they are spending more intensive training dollars on the individual and only enroll them in Dislocated Worker services at that latter point. This creates what *may appear* to be a much higher level of enrollment numbers for Dislocated Workers in Oregon when compared to other states. The Youth numbers are more similar and comparable because Youth are not registered in the same co-enrollment system as adults. Please note the trend line for both states begins to drop proportionately as the recovery from the Great Recession occurred.

Public University Enrollment, Fall Term Headcount by Fee Status and Institution (2014 OSU, PSU, and UO)

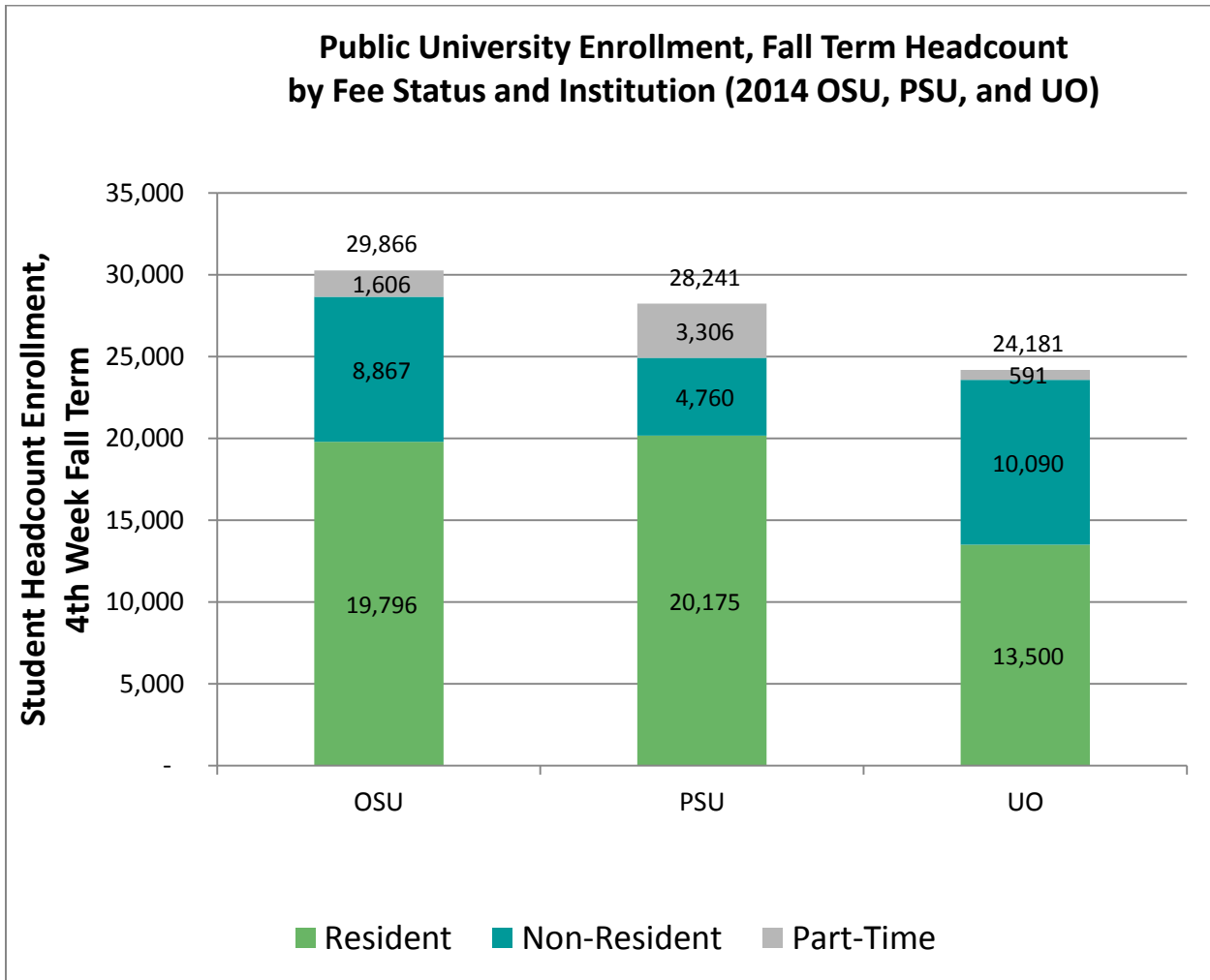

by Fee Status and Institution (2014 TRUs: EOU, OIT, SOU, WOU)**

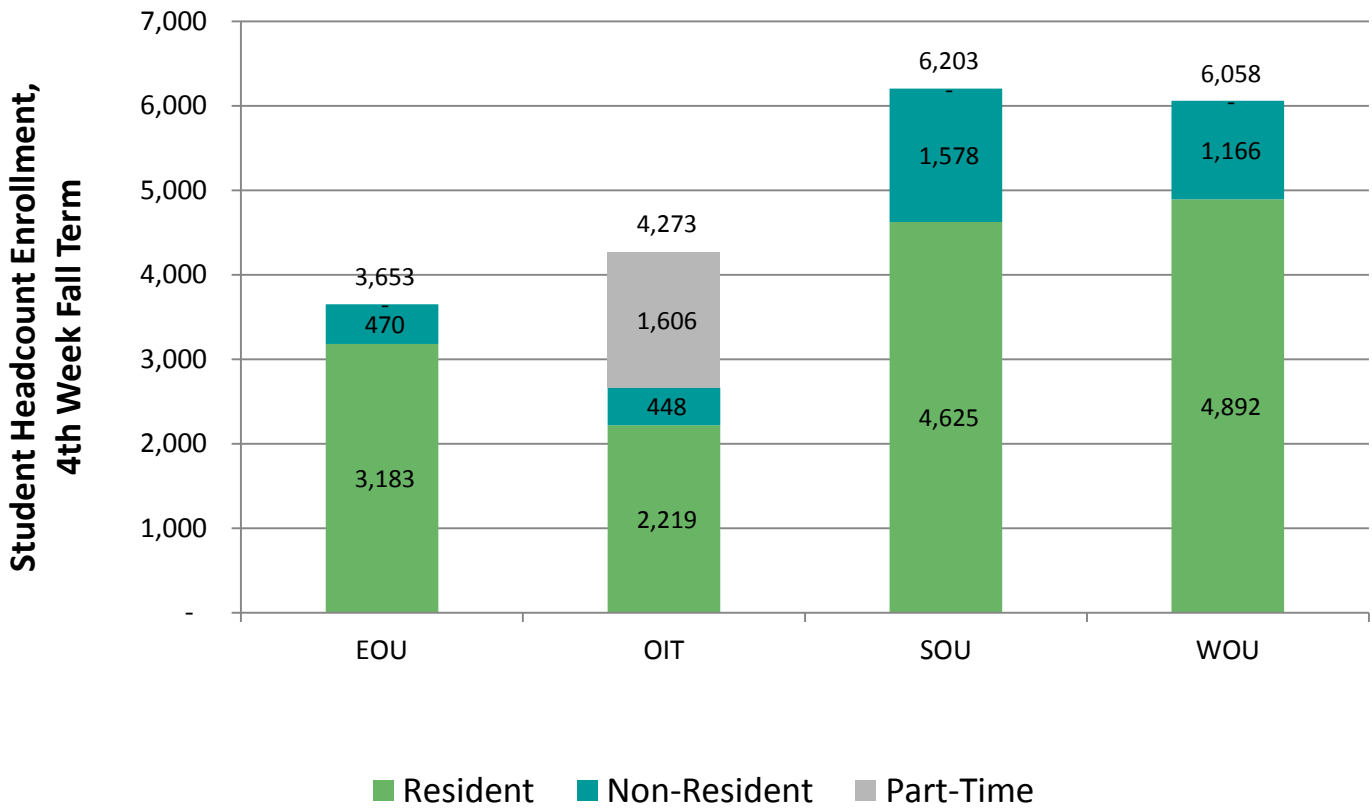

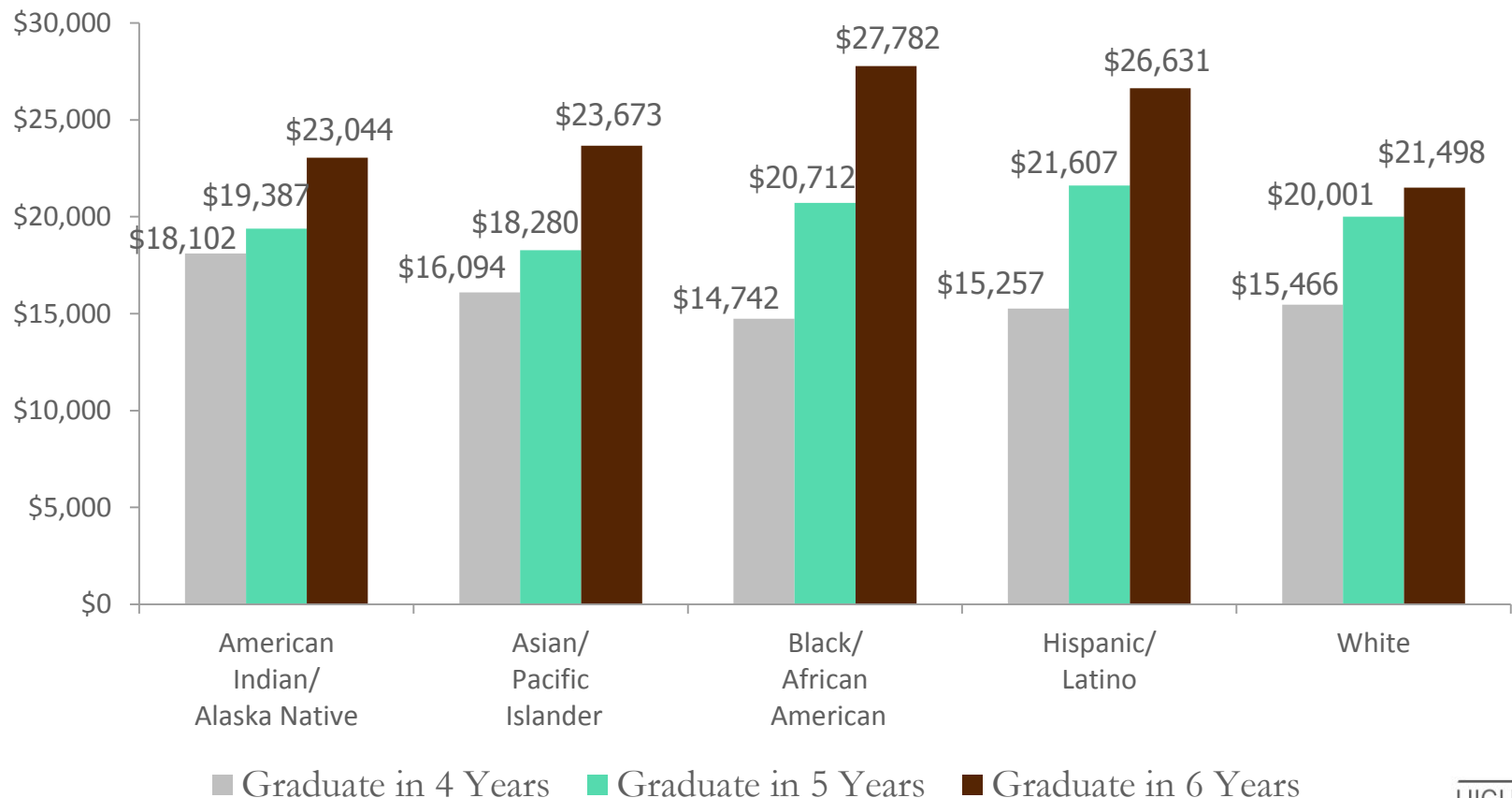
