Measure Description:

Requires State Board of Education to adopt rules under which school personnel may administer medications that treat adrenal insufficiency to students experiencing adrenal crisis.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Board of Nursing, Board of Pharmacy, Department of Education, Oregon Health Authority (OHA), School Districts

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill makes changes to ORS 433.810 which affects workloads in the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). OHA has a fiscal impact associated with this bill. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
