Measure Description:

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to evaluate methods to improve effectiveness of public education at university level.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Higher Education Coordinating Commission

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes the Open Educational Resources Grant Program within the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) and appropriates \$1.1 million General Fund to the HECC. The bill also would require HECC to establish a position to carry-out the requirements of the bill. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
