**Measure Description:**

Establishes State Apprenticeship Education and Training Fund and continuously appropriates moneys in fund to State Apprenticeship and Training Council and Bureau of Labor and Industries for specified purposes.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI), Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Oregon Military Department, Cities, Counties, Department of Education

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:** This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes the State Apprenticeship Education and Training Fund and appropriates money. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Further Analysis Required
