WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires law enforcement agency to establish policies and procedures for retaining recordings from cameras worn upon police officer's person to record officer's interactions with members of public. Provides exemption from required disclosure under public records law of recordings made of law enforcement officer's interactions with public. Creates exceptions to exemption. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

BACKGROUND: Senate Bill 236 requires law enforcement agencies to establish policies and procedures for retaining recordings from cameras worn upon police officer's person to record the officer's interactions with members of the public. The bill provides exemption from required disclosures under public records law of recordings made with certain exceptions. Senate Bill 236 declares an emergency and is effective on passage.
