If any member of the public who is recorded wants disclosure, then it should be disclosed for their own immediate safety and future civil or criminal liability for consultation with legal counsel.

No law shall be passed granting to any citizen or class of citizens privileges, or immunities, which, upon the same terms, shall not equally belong to all citizens. If you allow citizen's behavior to be immune to exposure, then you must give it to all; not just for a particular incident. This is a public record. Disclosure must be the assumed always to be in the public interest until proven otherwise.

An order by an officer of any sort is use of force because of their authority and intimidation by force of arms. Any request for disclosure is in the public interest. Every time one citizen is not cited and another is, the disclosure of that is in the public interest.
