Measure Description:

Directs Oregon Health Authority to develop program for screening students in this state who are susceptible to tooth decay and providing dental sealants for those students.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill [may] [does not] affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting Senate Bill 660 with the – 3 amendment from the Senate Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The bill appropriates an unspecified amount of General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) for the 2015-17 biennium, and directs the agency to screen, and ensure the provision of dental sealants to student populations who attend an elementary school or a middle school in which at least 40% of students are eligible to receive assistance under the USDA National School Lunch Program.

The bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Oregon Health Authority. The amount of this impact is still being determined.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
