Dear Chair Vega Pederson and House Energy and Environment Committee,

I am writing in strong support of House **Bill 3470 (known as the Climate Stability and Justice Act)**.

Of all of the bills you will be considering at your Committee Hearing on April 14th, **HB 3470** is the strongest climate policy and, with a few minor modifications to the current version of the bill, can easily accomplish these key objectives:

- Limits and reduces greenhouse gas emissions with specific targets & timelines
- Requires use of best science to identify key targets
- Provides state agency responsibility and authority
- Gives state agency strategic implementation discretion to meet targets
- Requires five year reporting & strategic adjustments
- Must include full accounting methods for carbon emissions (aka: life cycle analysis)
- Provides mitigation for low income communities
- Integrates existing regulations into single comprehensive program
- Integrates with neighboring state actions for a greater consistency and impact

Please support **HB 3470** and do all you can to advance **HB 3470** this session!
